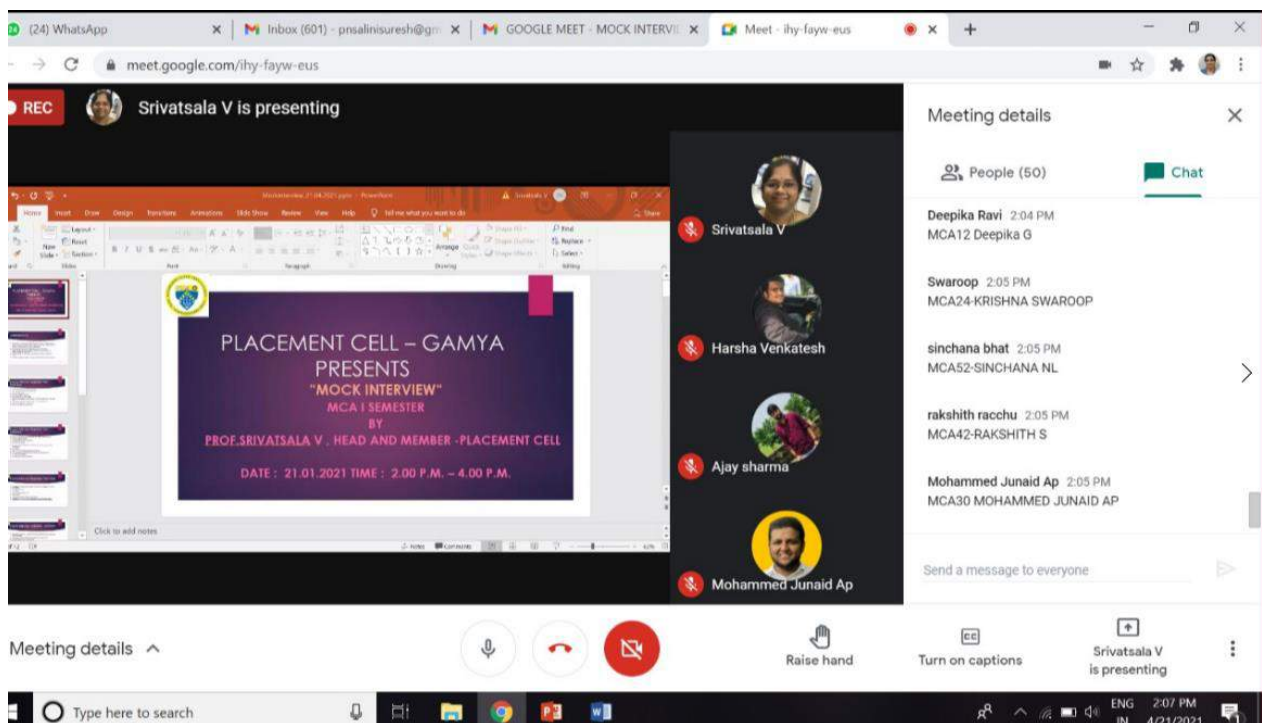


Photo 1 : Introduction Slide of Mock interview

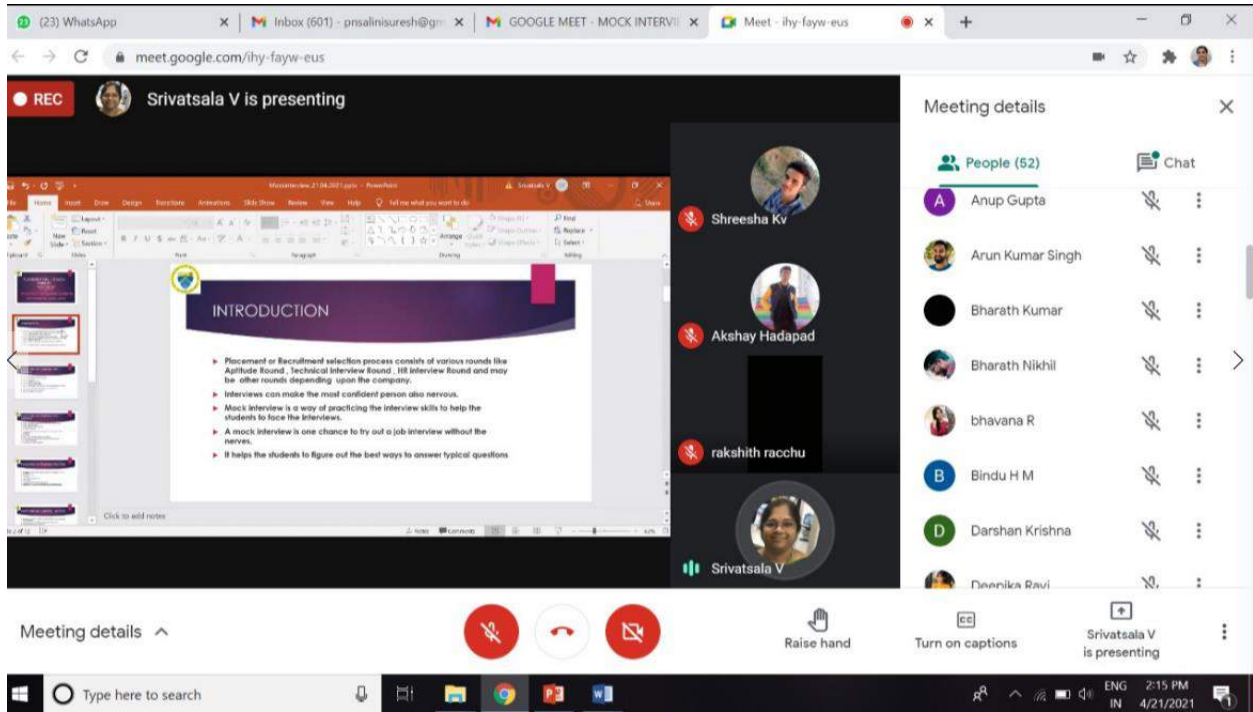


Photo 2 : Introduction to Mock Interview

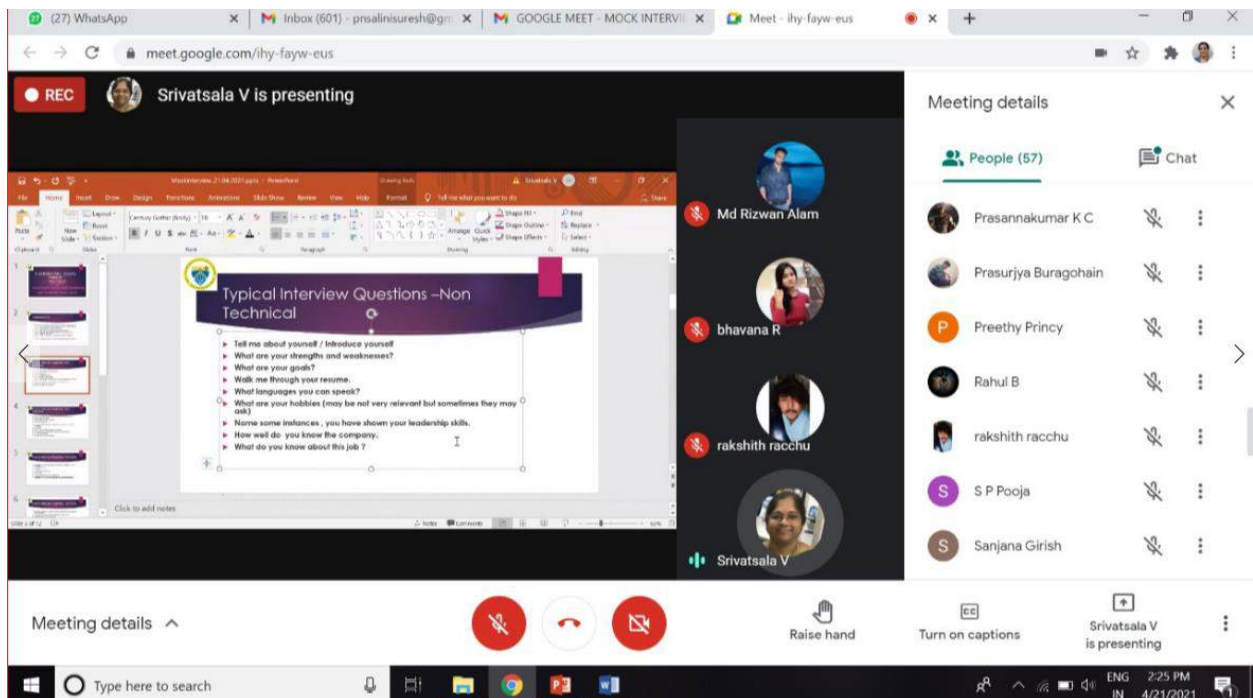


Photo 3: Non Technical Interview

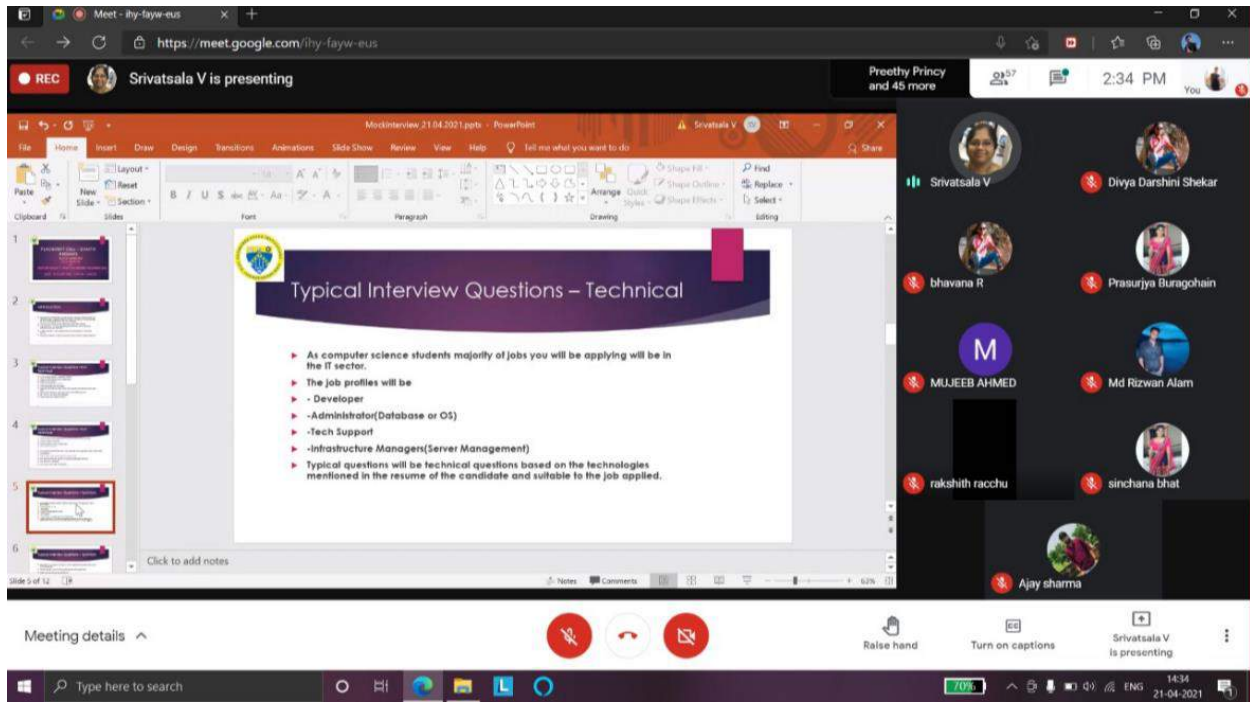


Photo 4 : Non Technical interview

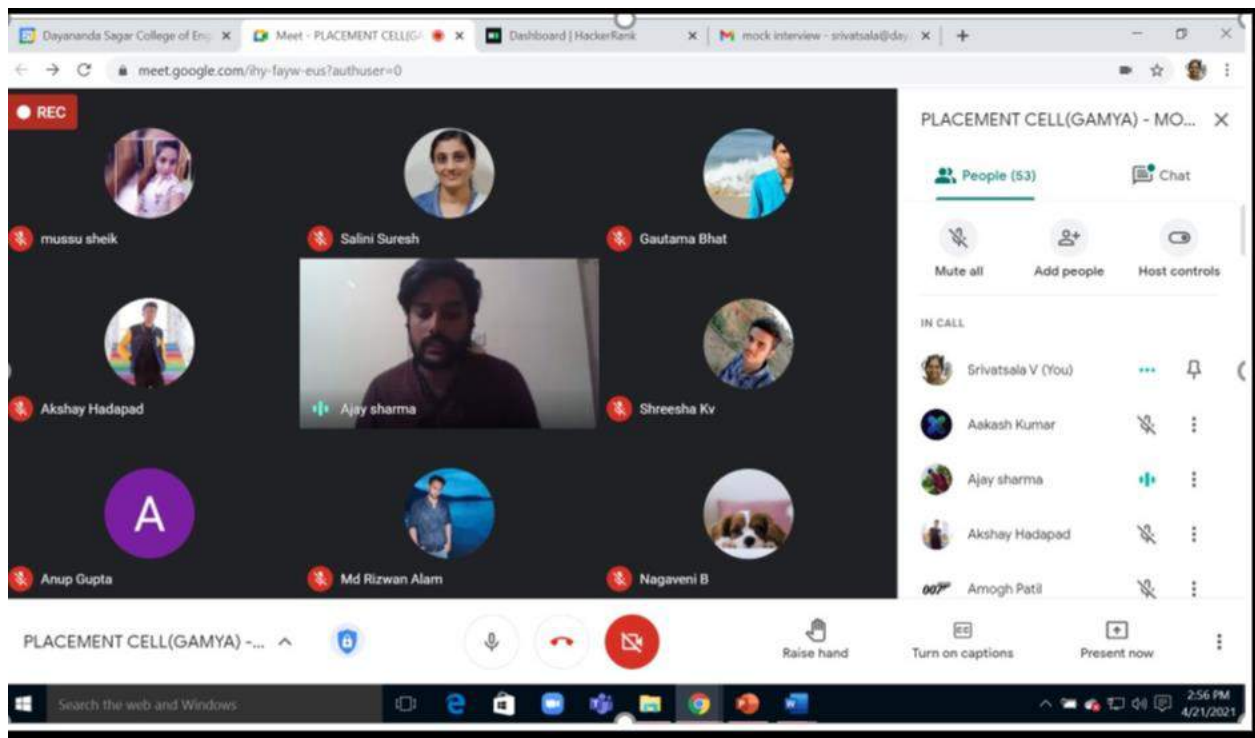


Photo 5 : Activity - Mock Interview

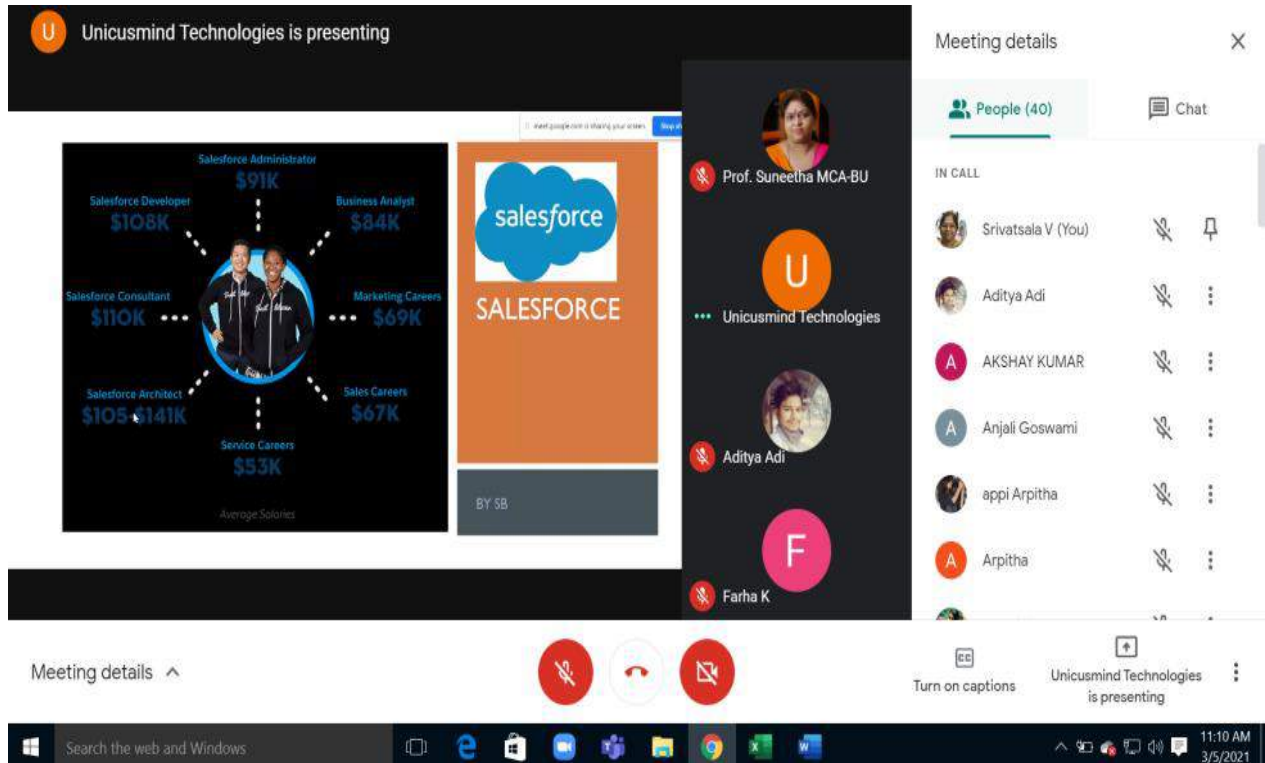


Photo 1 : Salesforce job opportunities

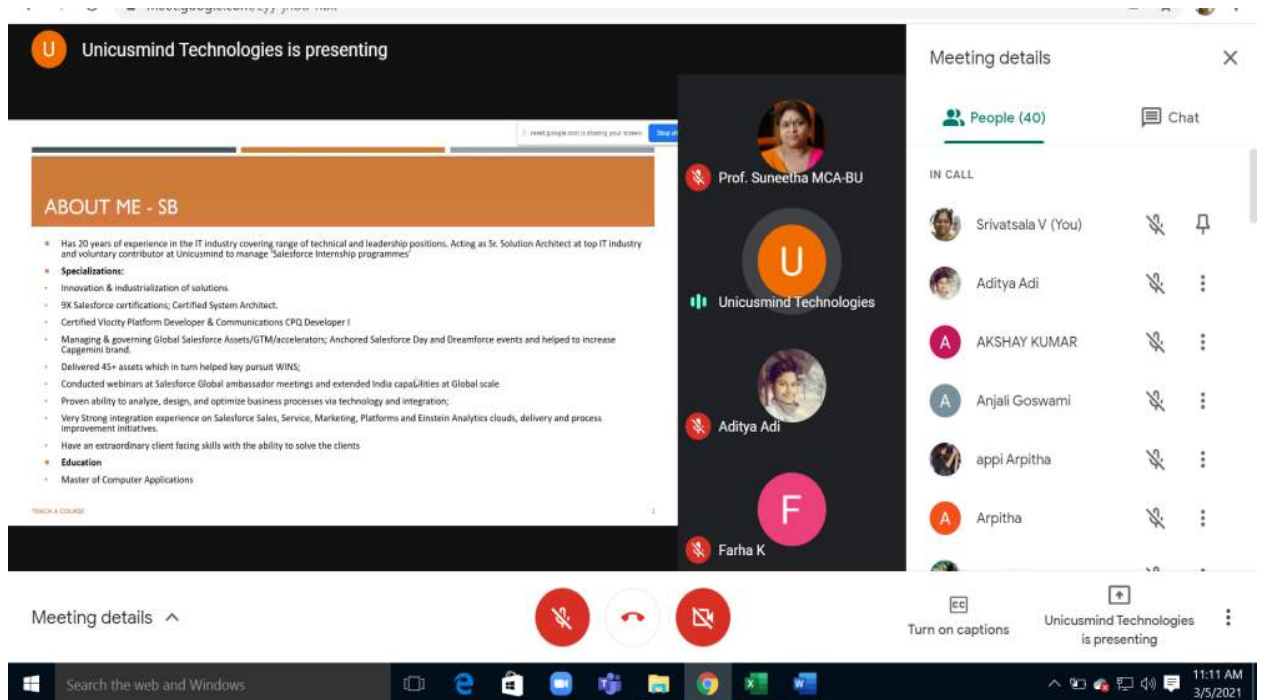


Photo 2: Speaker Seshu B s profile

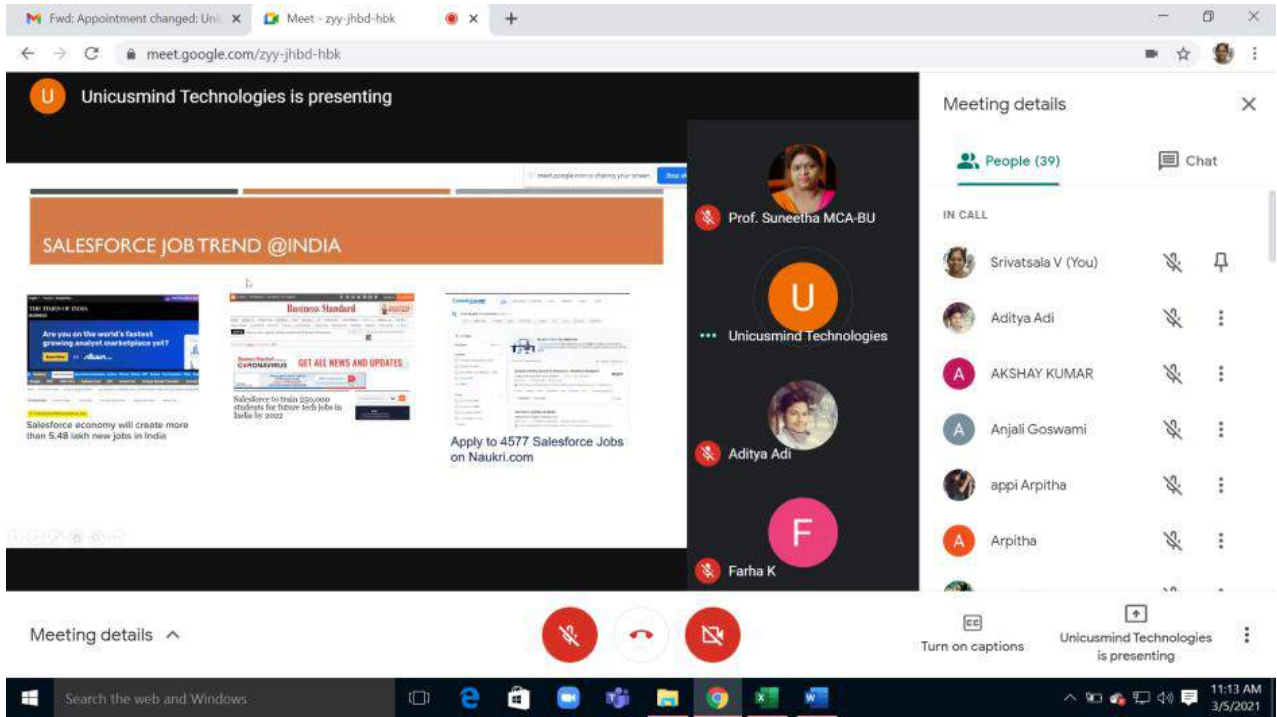


Photo 3 : Job trends at Salesforce

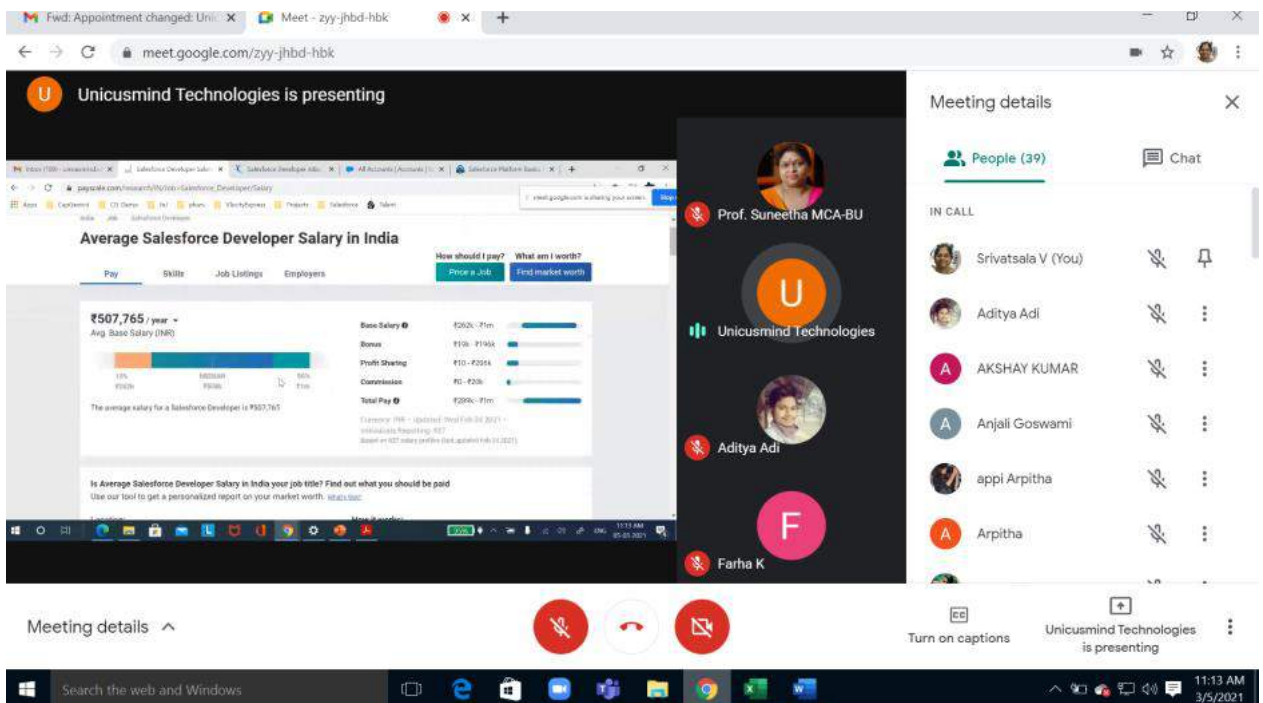


Photo 4 : Average Salary for Salesforce Developer

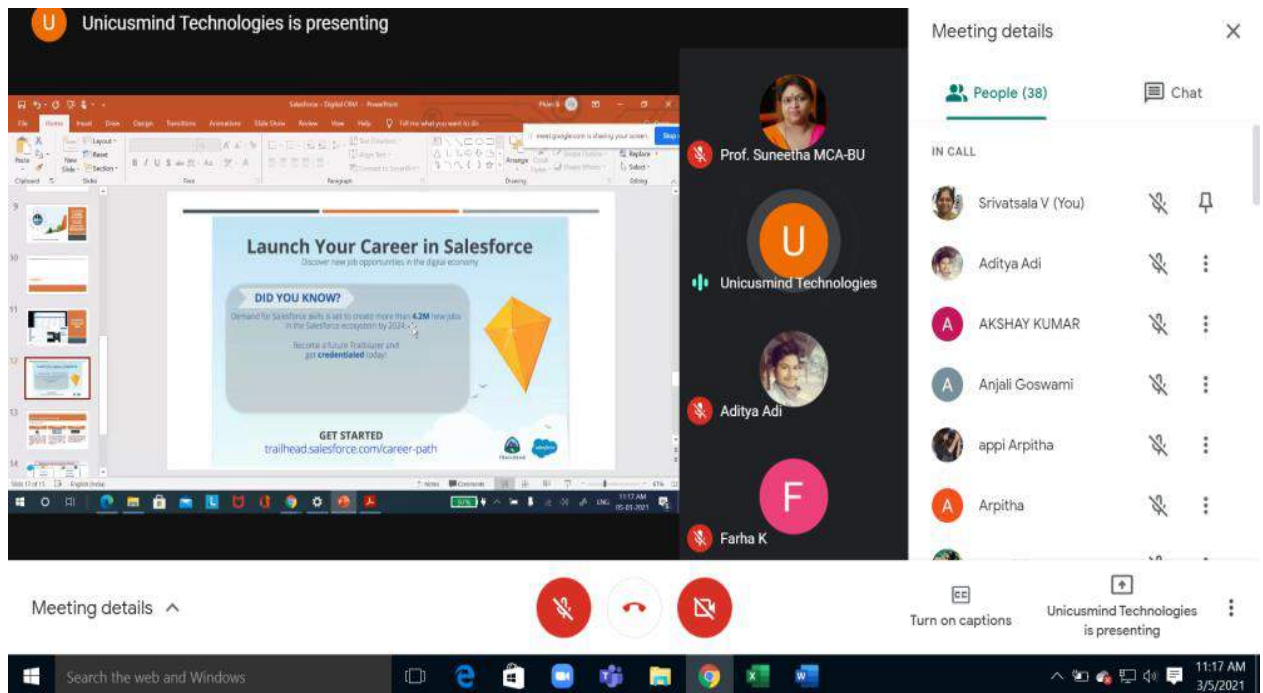


Photo 5 : Launching Career in Salesforce

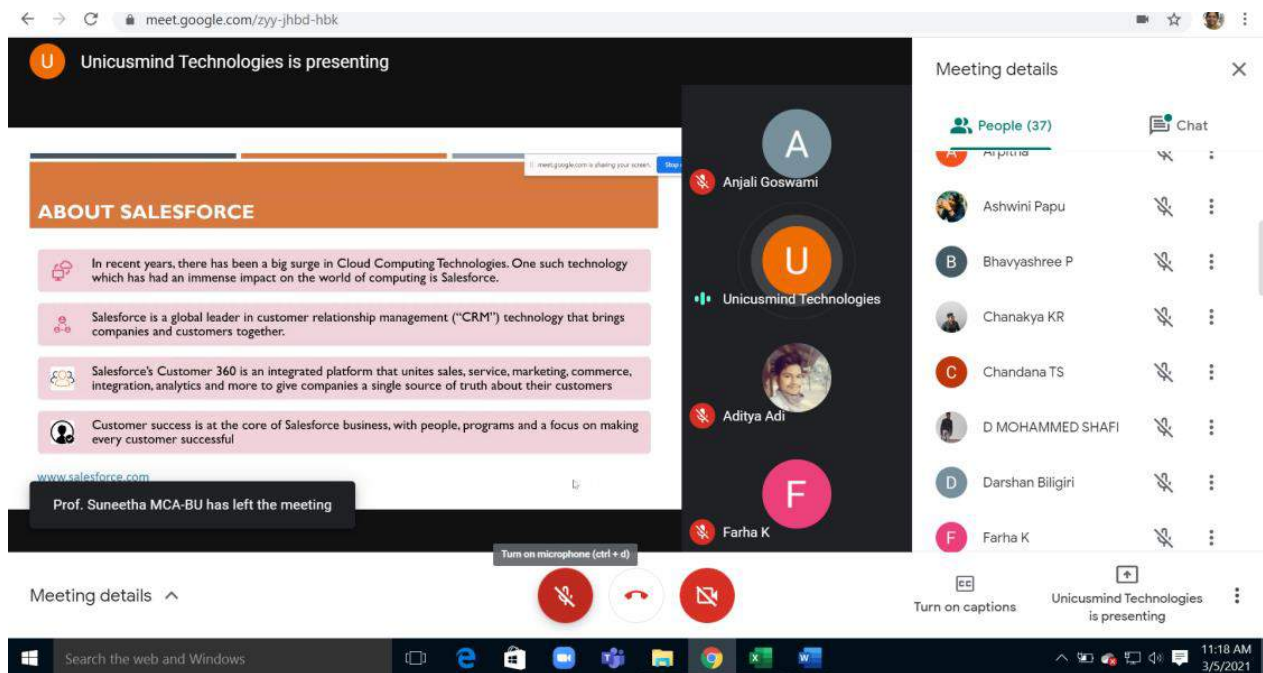


Photo 6 : About Salesforce



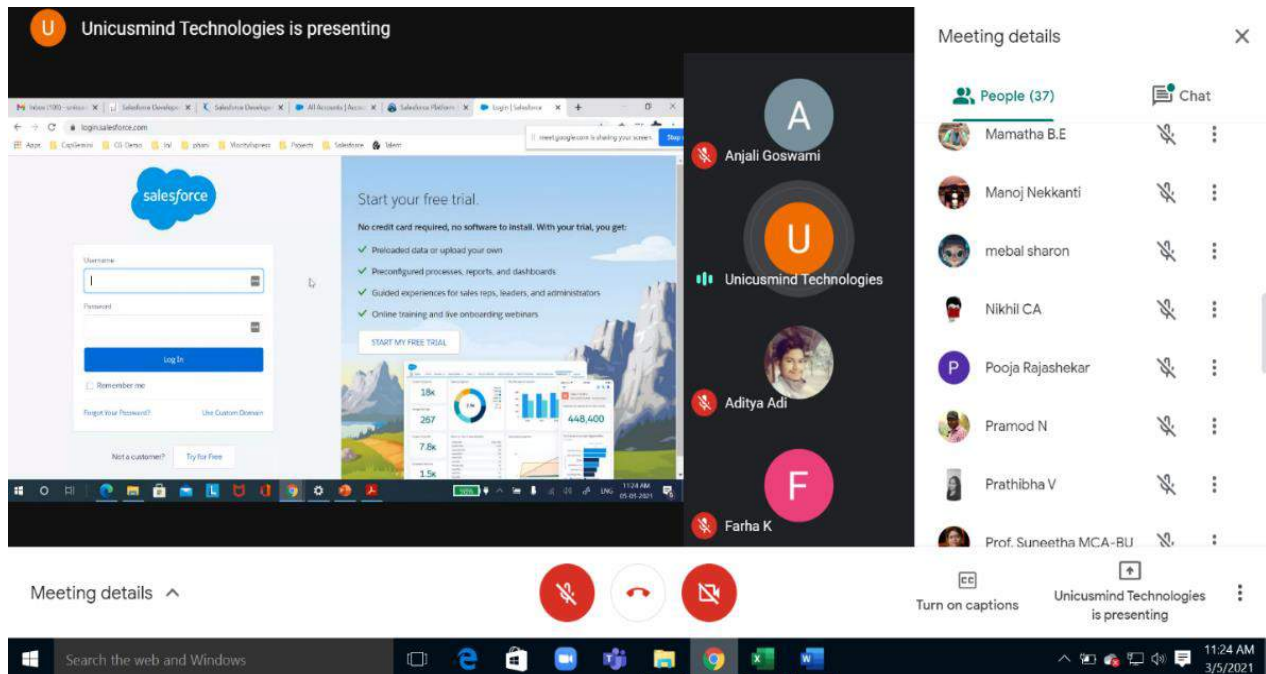


Photo 7 : Salesforce Demo

He gave valuable references to the students where they can learn and train in the latest technologies. The speaker patiently cleared all the doubts and had given lot of insights into the current trends in the IT market.

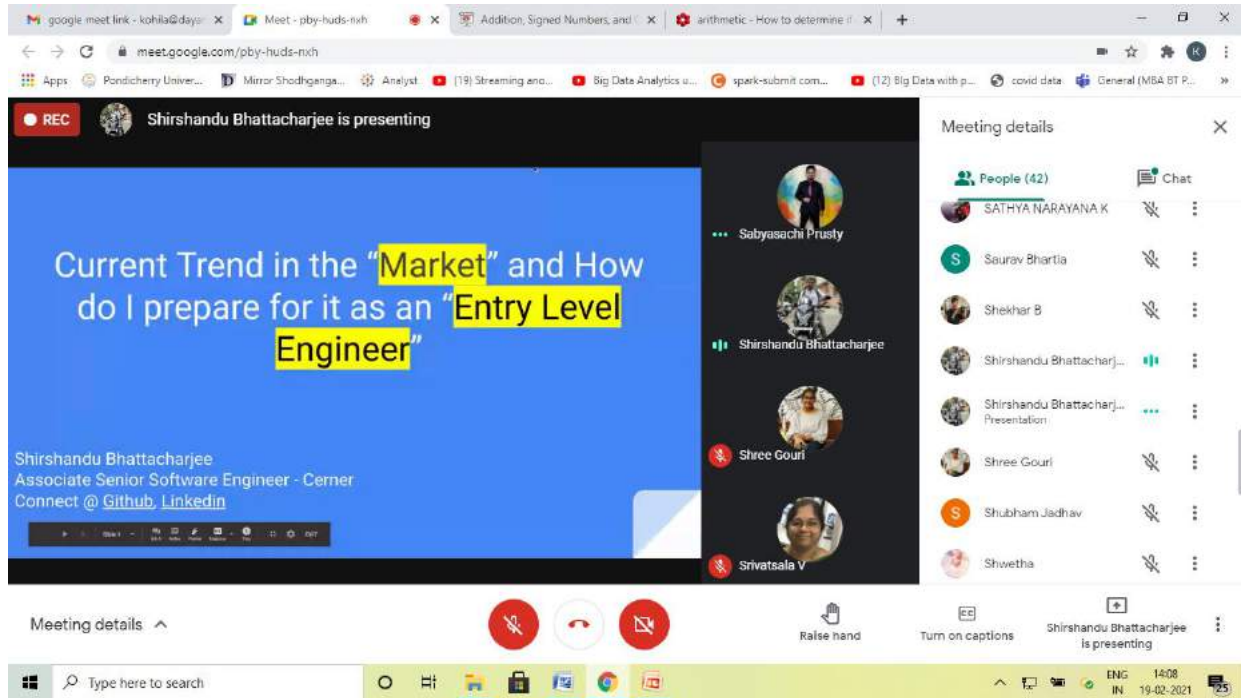


Photo 1: Current trends in the market

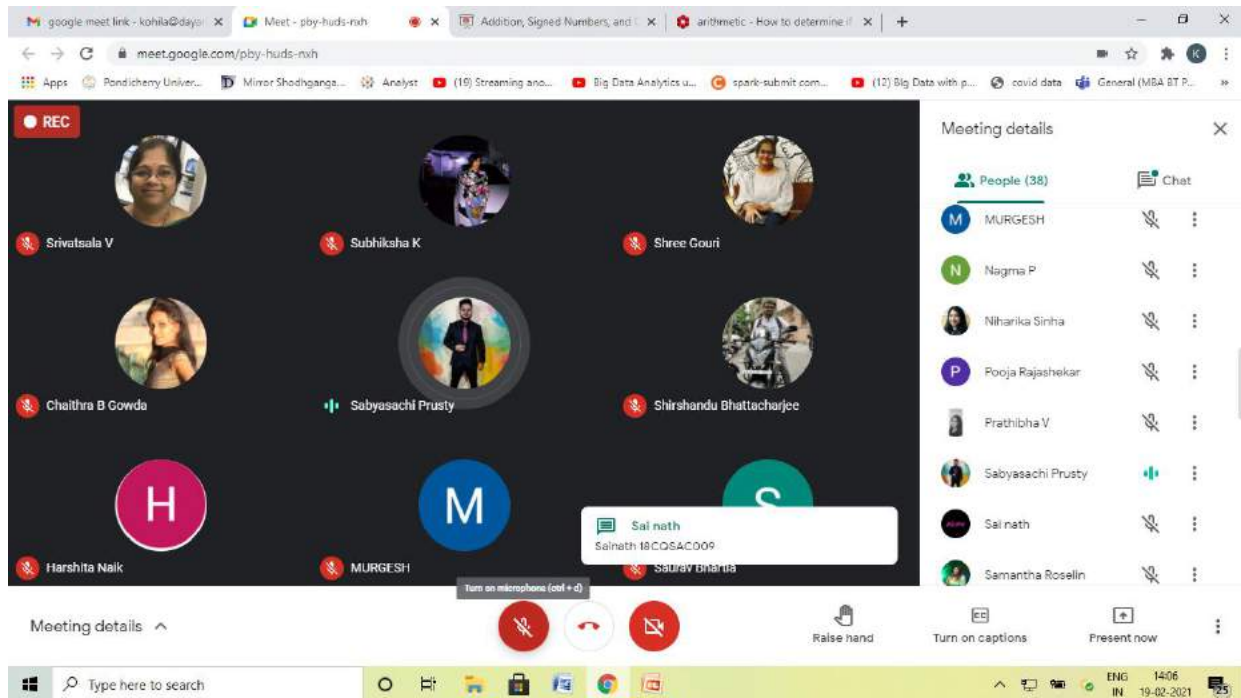


Photo 2: Gallery view of participants

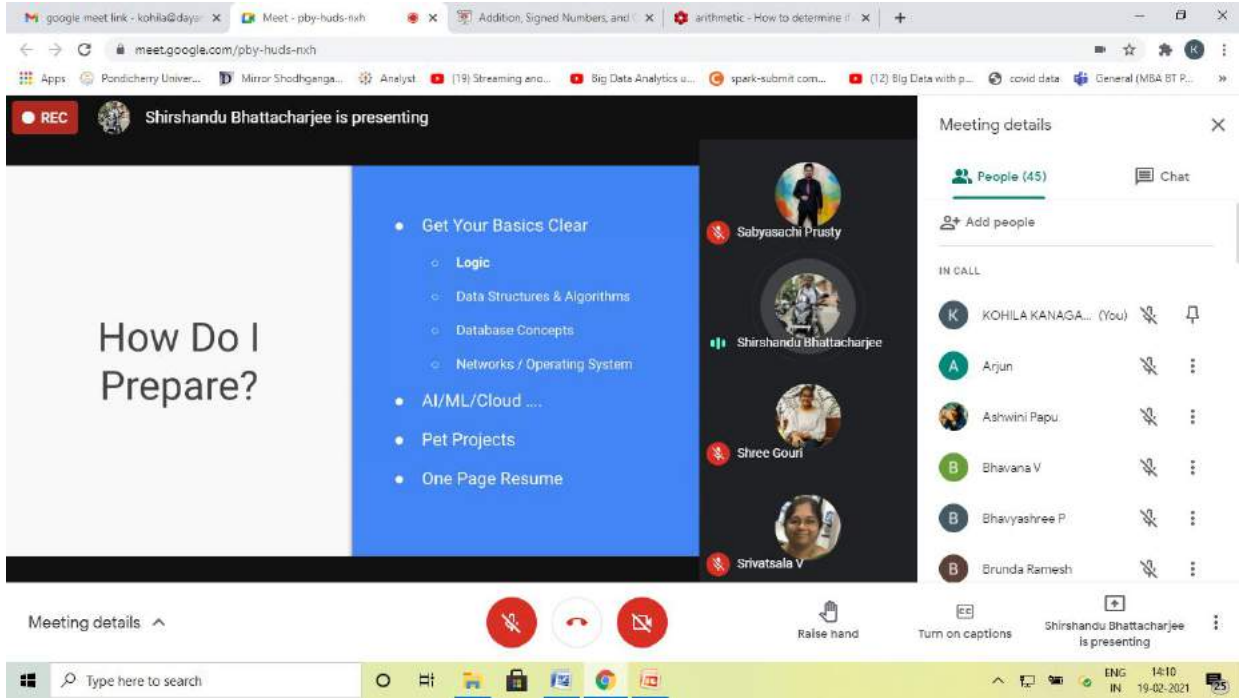


Photo 3: How to prepare for the IT industry

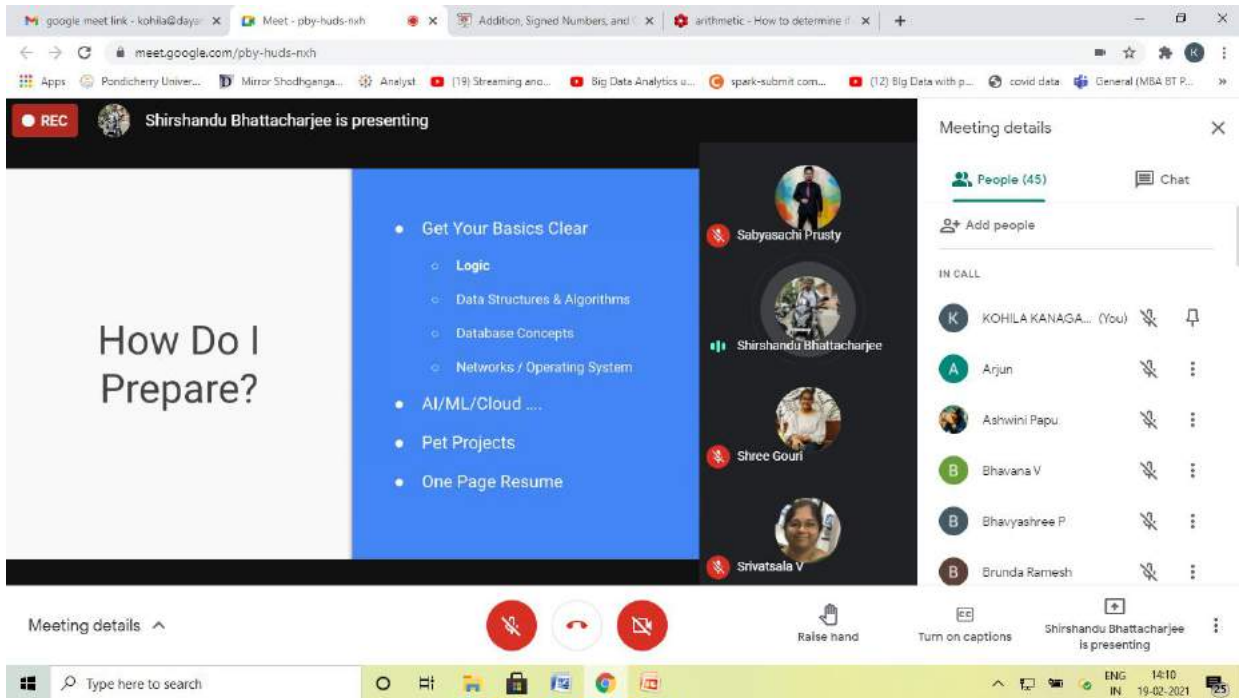


Photo 4: How to do pet projects

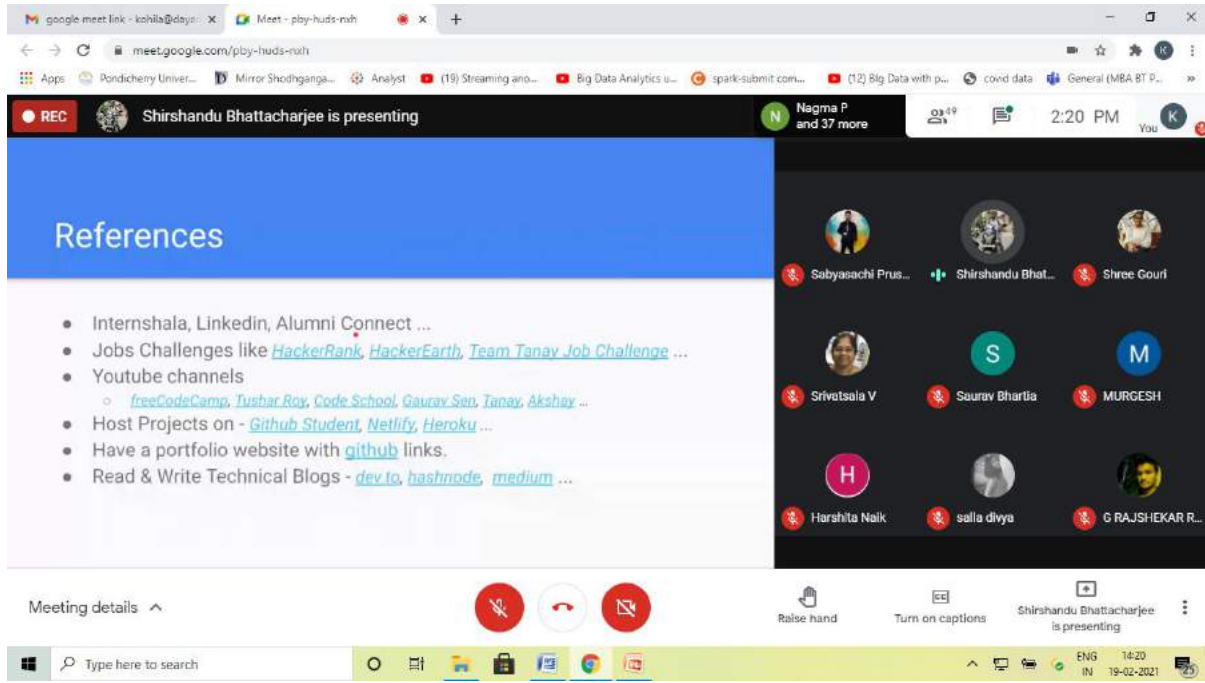


Photo 5 : References given for the preparation

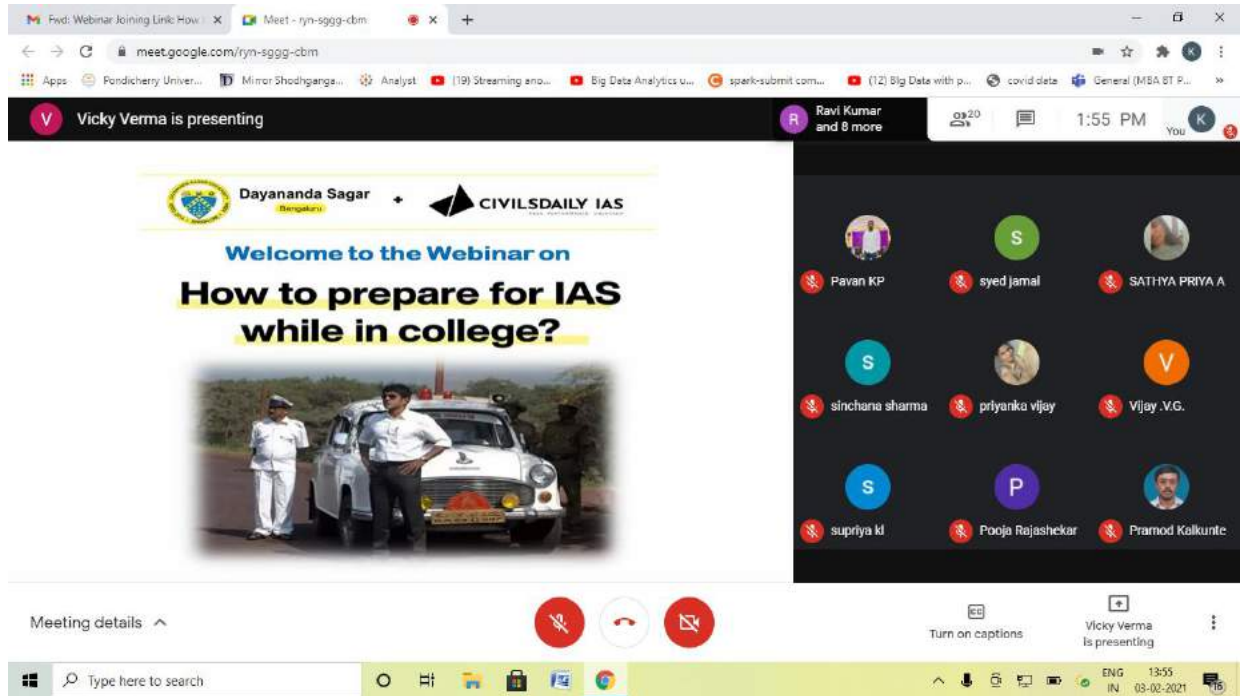


Photo 1: How to prepare for IAS

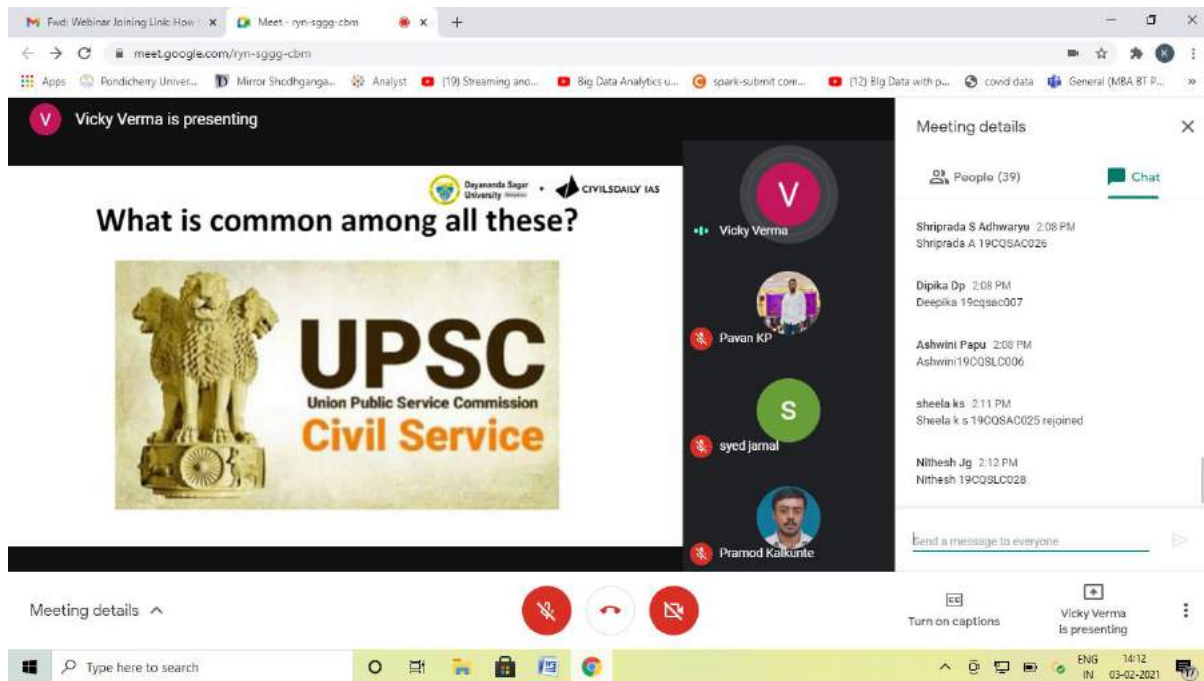


Photo 2: UPSC and its impact



Photo 3: Functions and responsibilities of District Collector

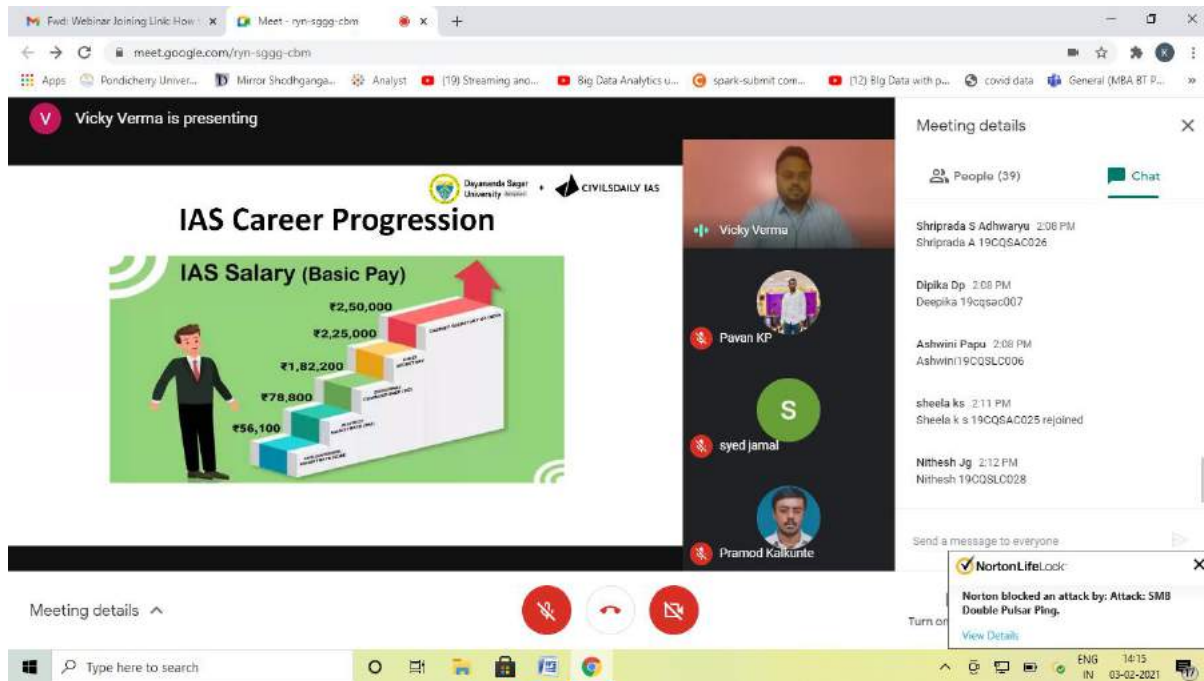


Photo 4 : IAS Career Progression

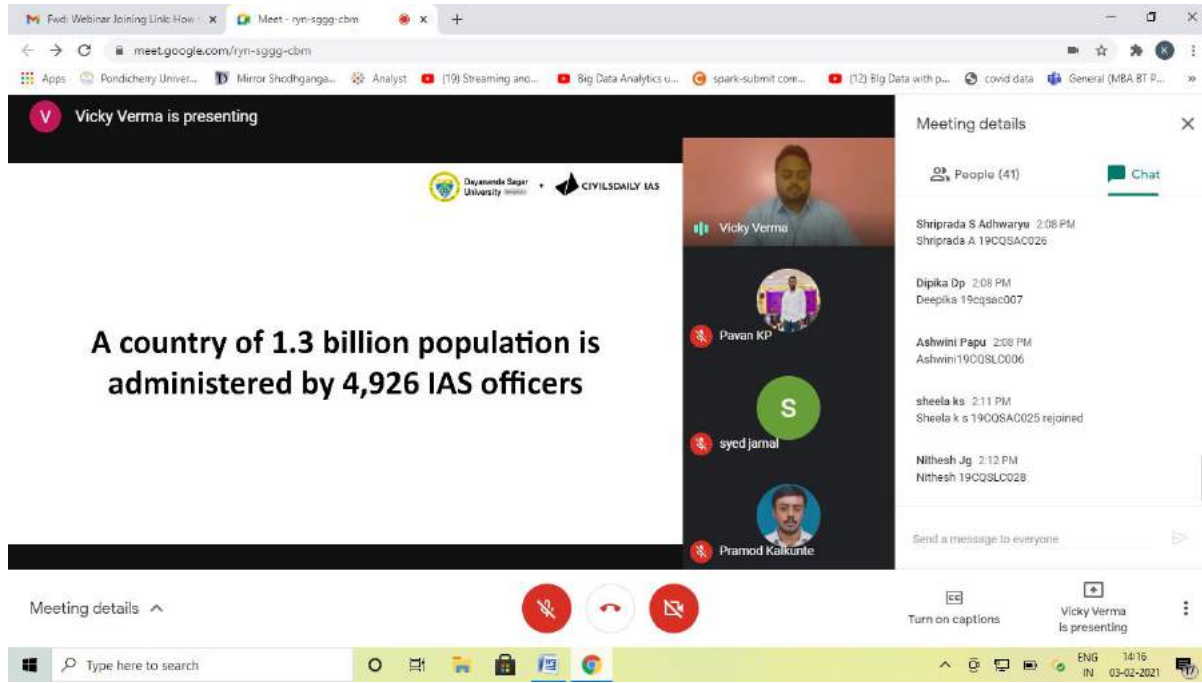


Photo 5 : Number of IAS officers in India

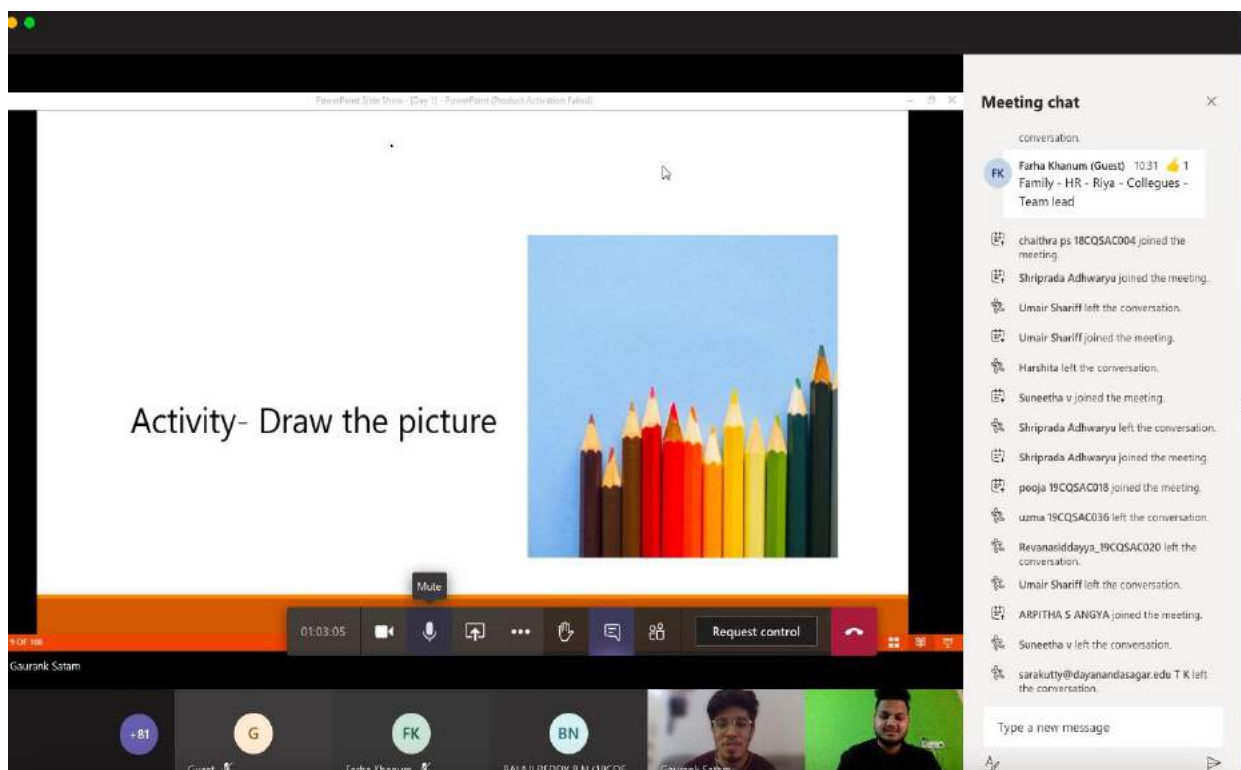


Photo 2 : Activity for the students

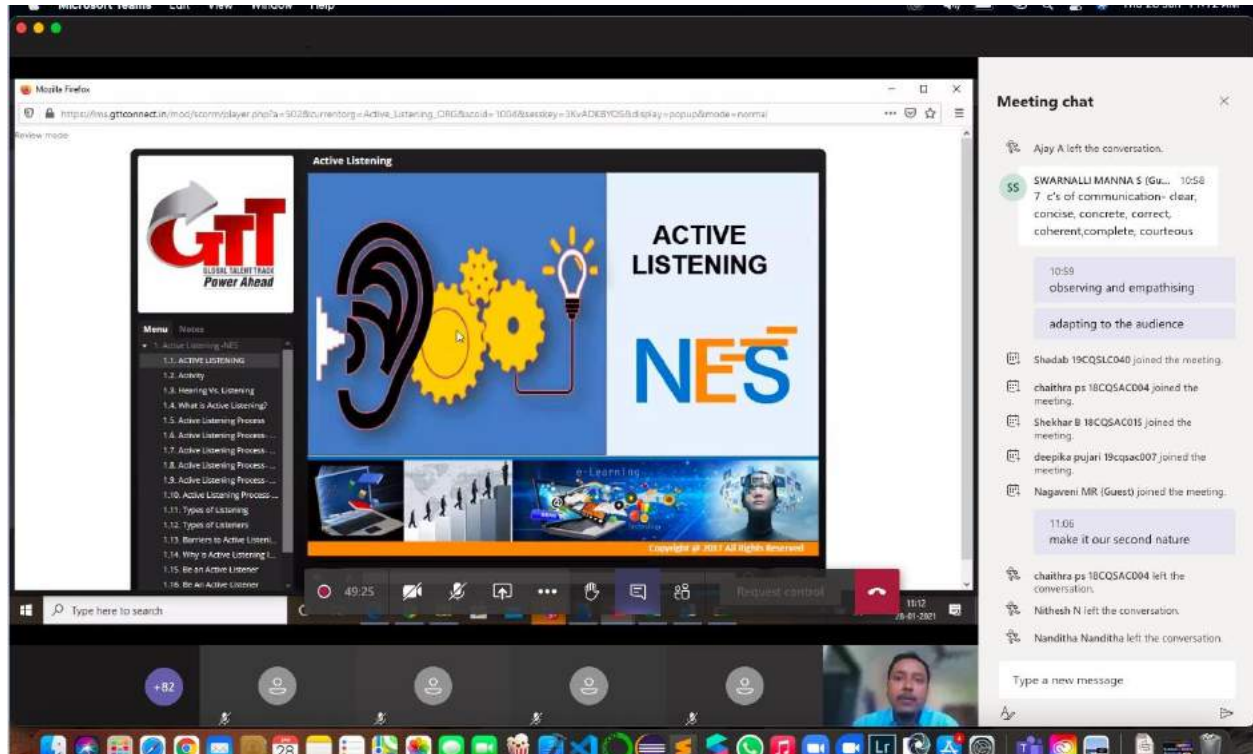


Photo 4:Active Listening

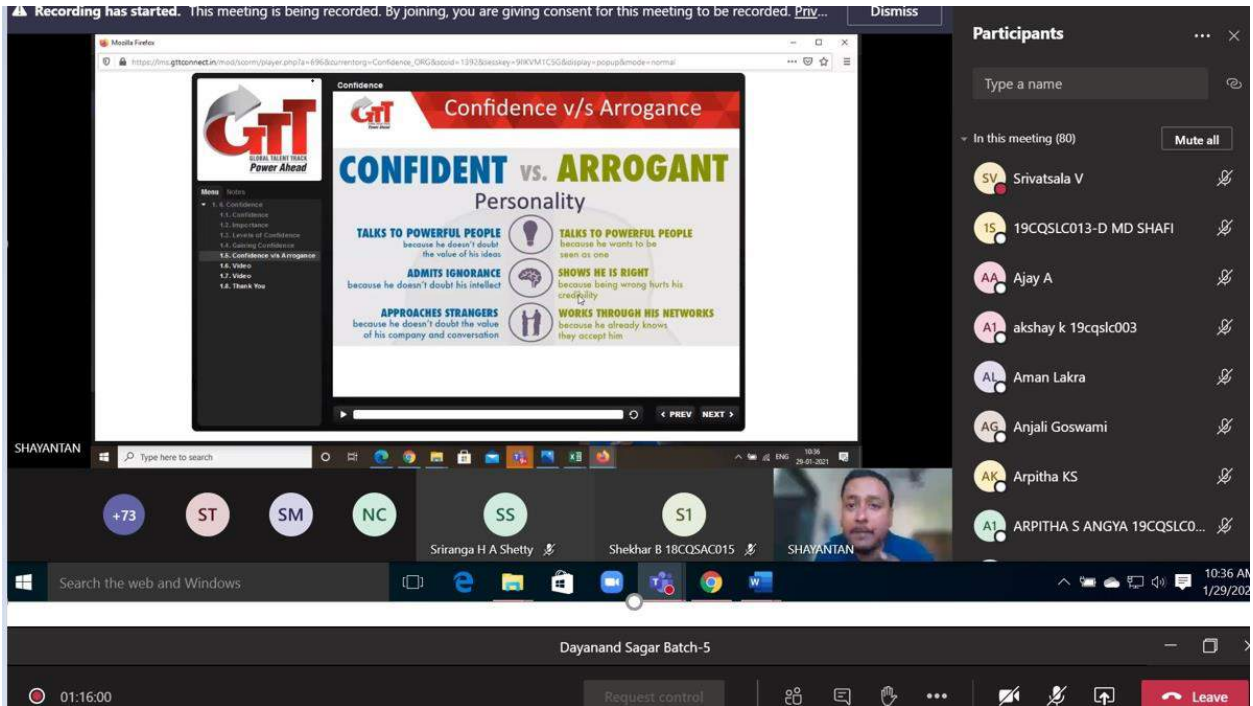


Photo 5 : Confidence Vs Arrogance

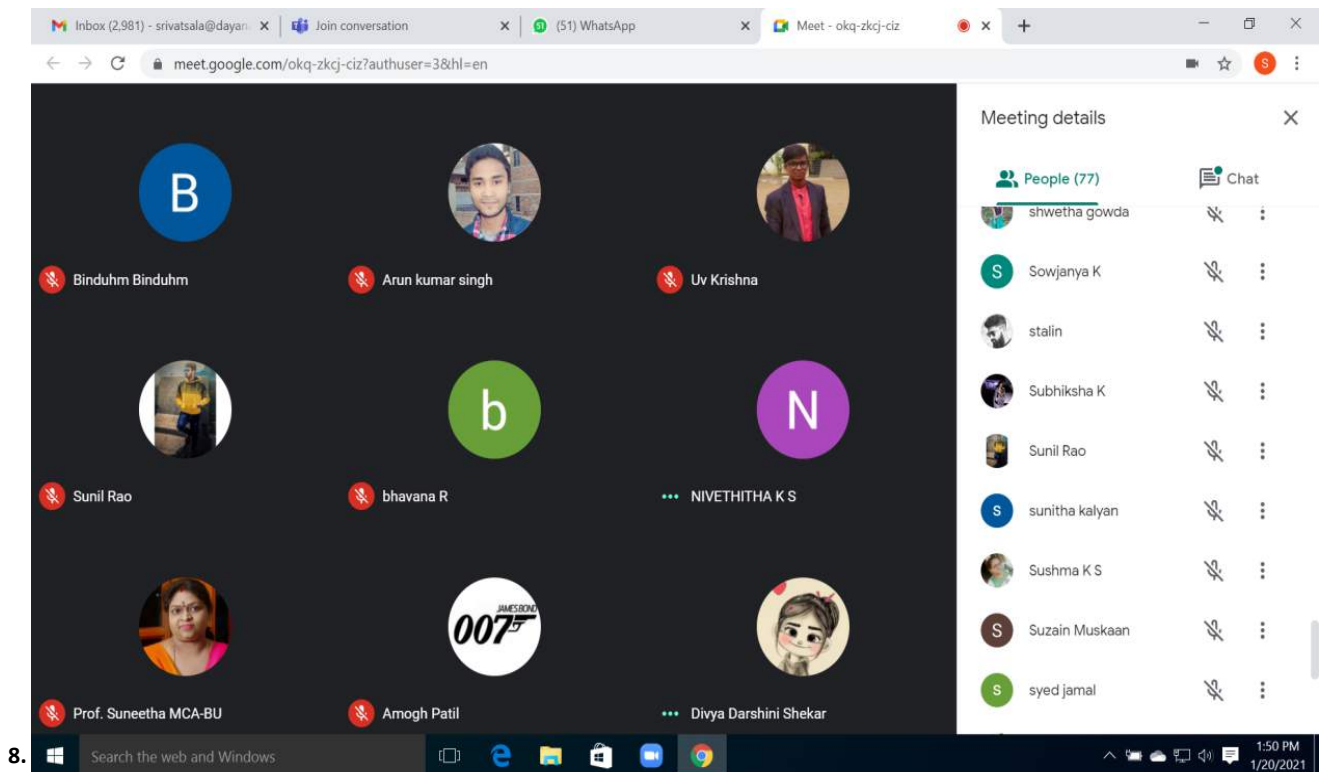
## 7. “Campus to Corporate” On 20-01-2021

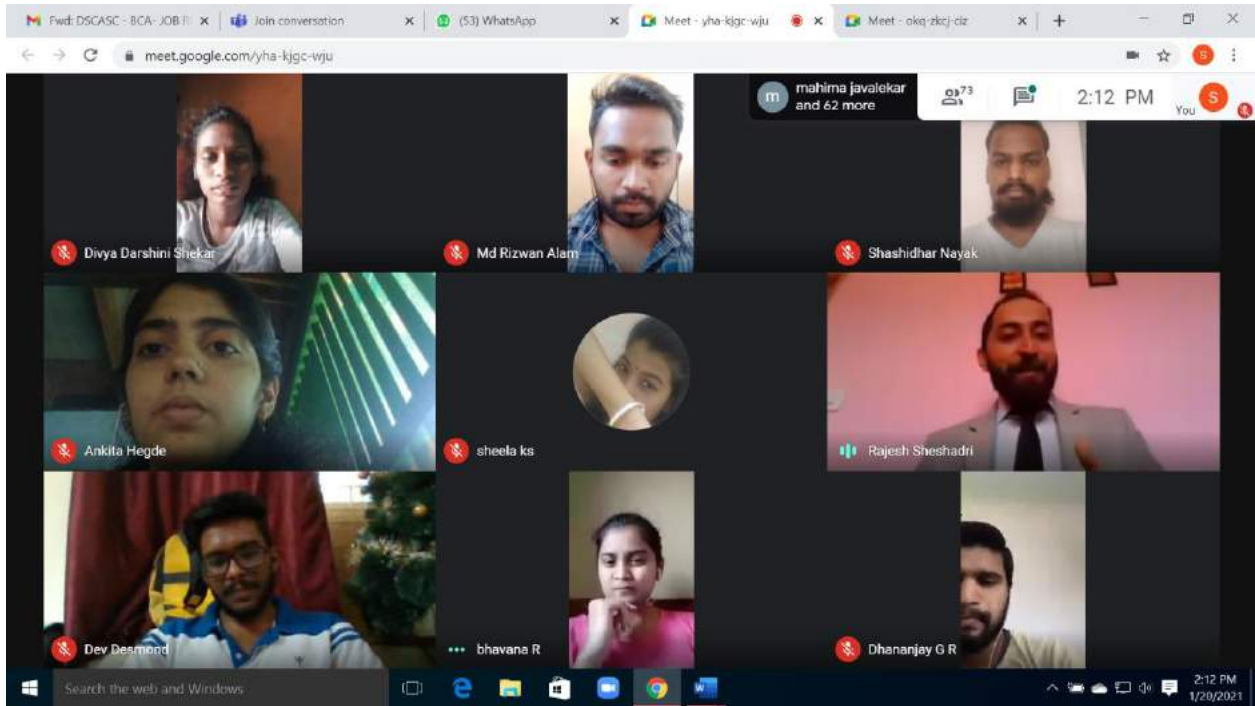

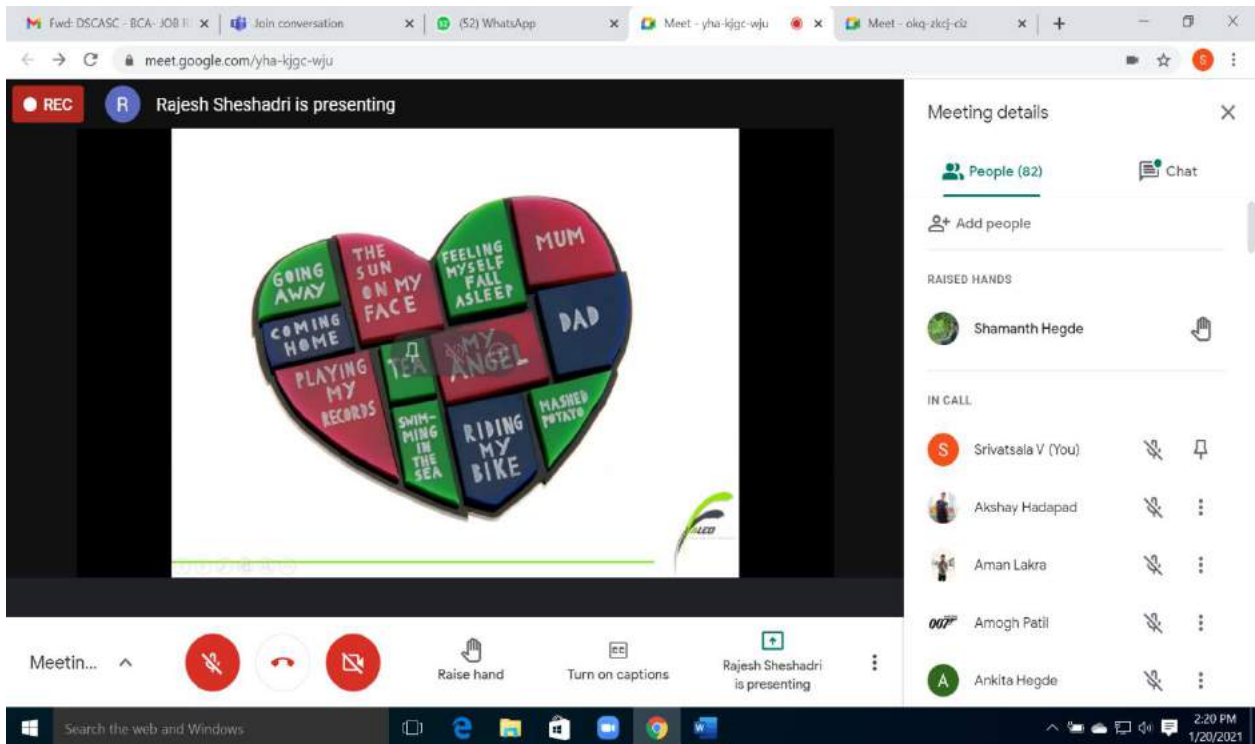


Photo 4: Priorities of a student.

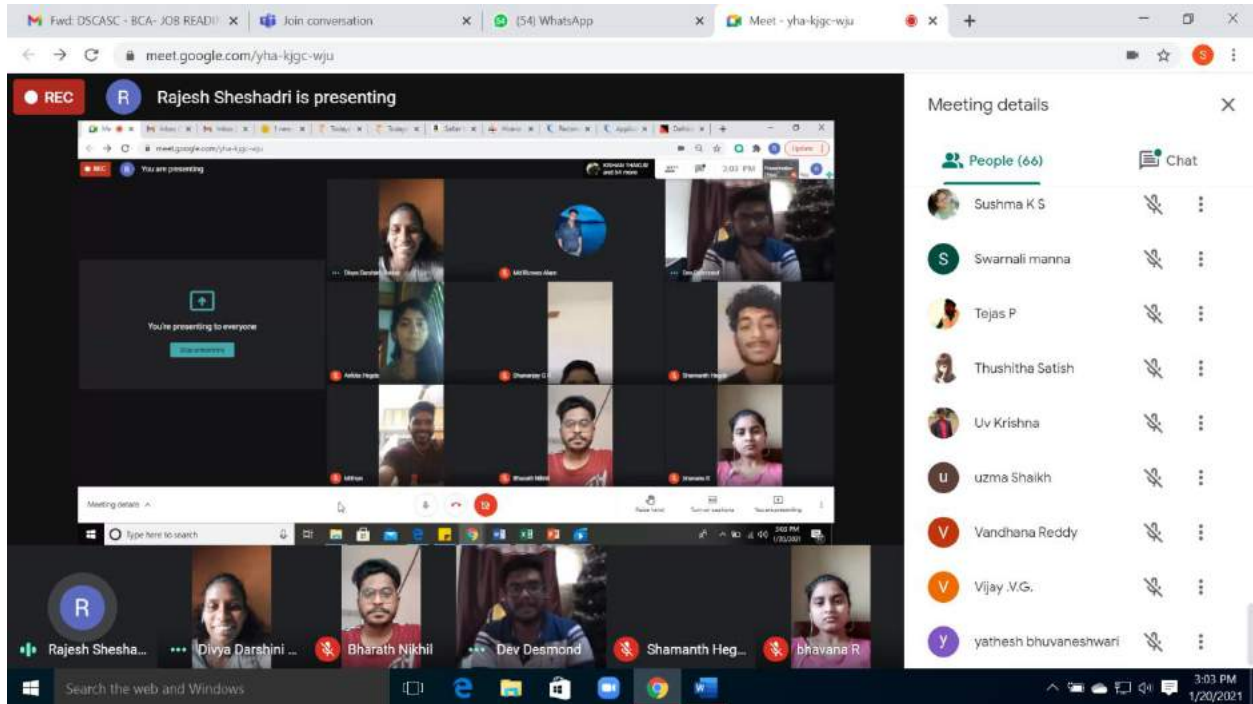


Photo 5 : Students interacting with the trainer during activity.

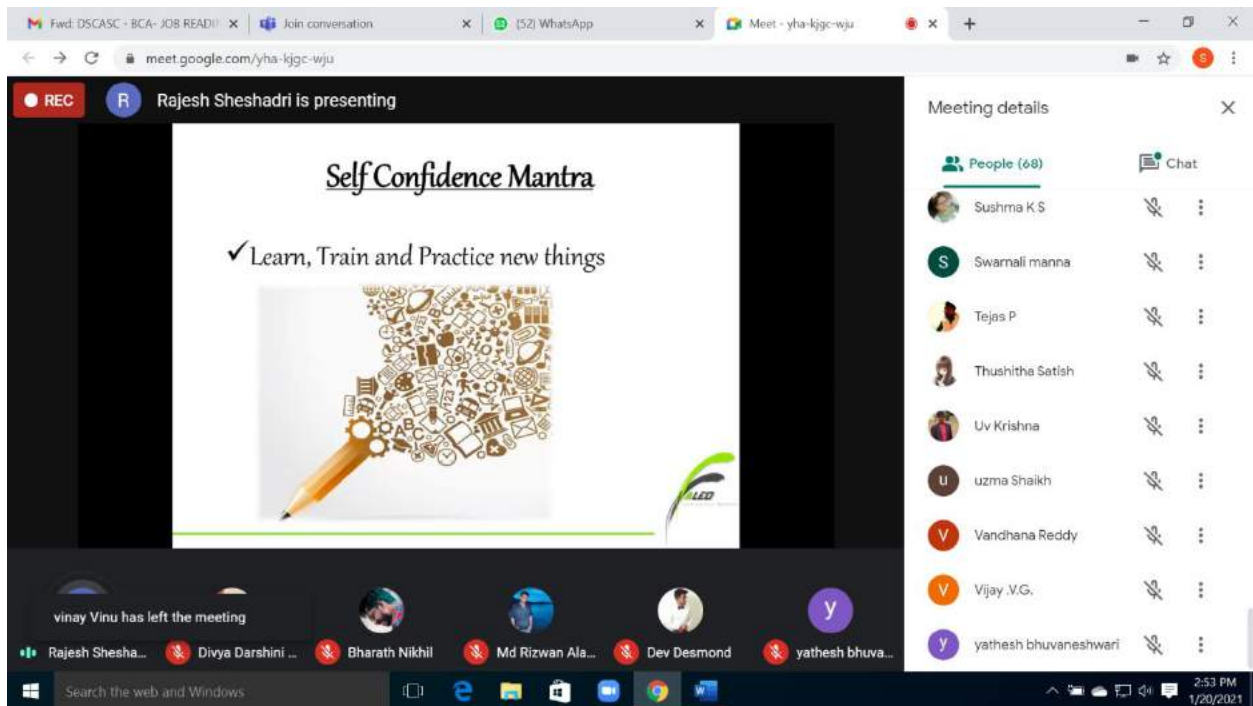


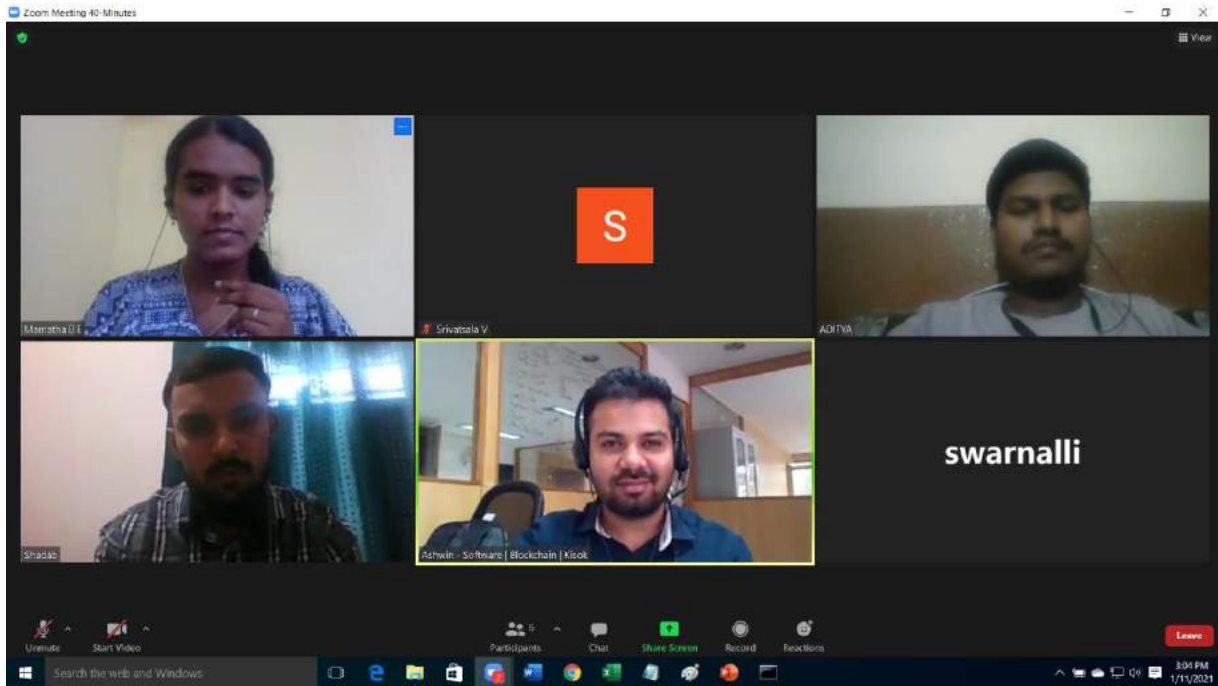
Photo 6 : Self -Confidence Mantra for the students.

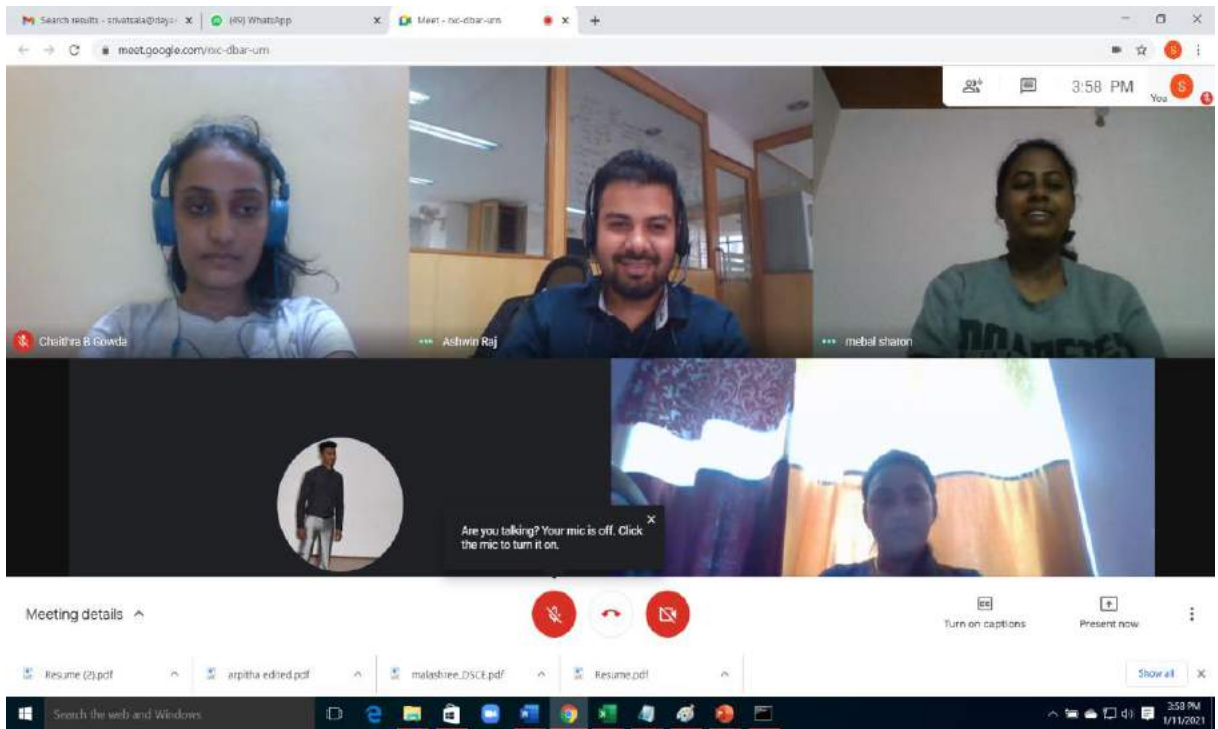


Photo 2 : Group 2 Interview

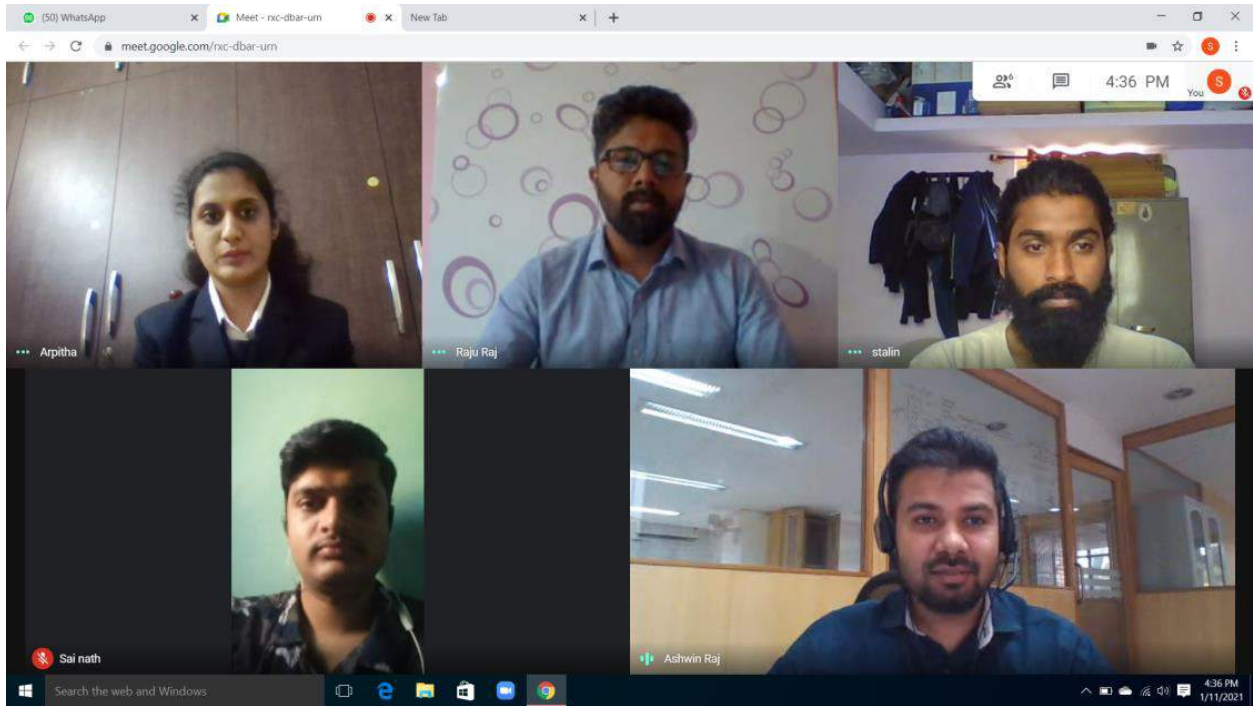


Photo 3 : Group 3 interview

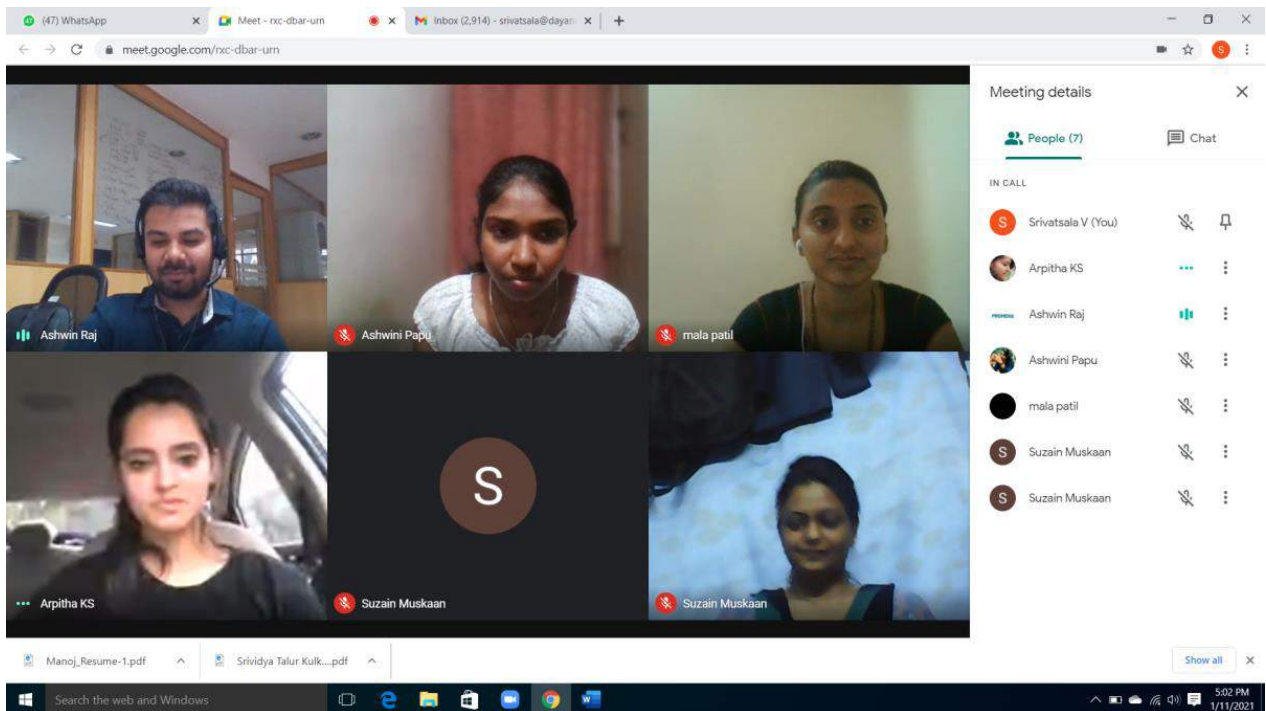


Photo 4 Group 4 interview



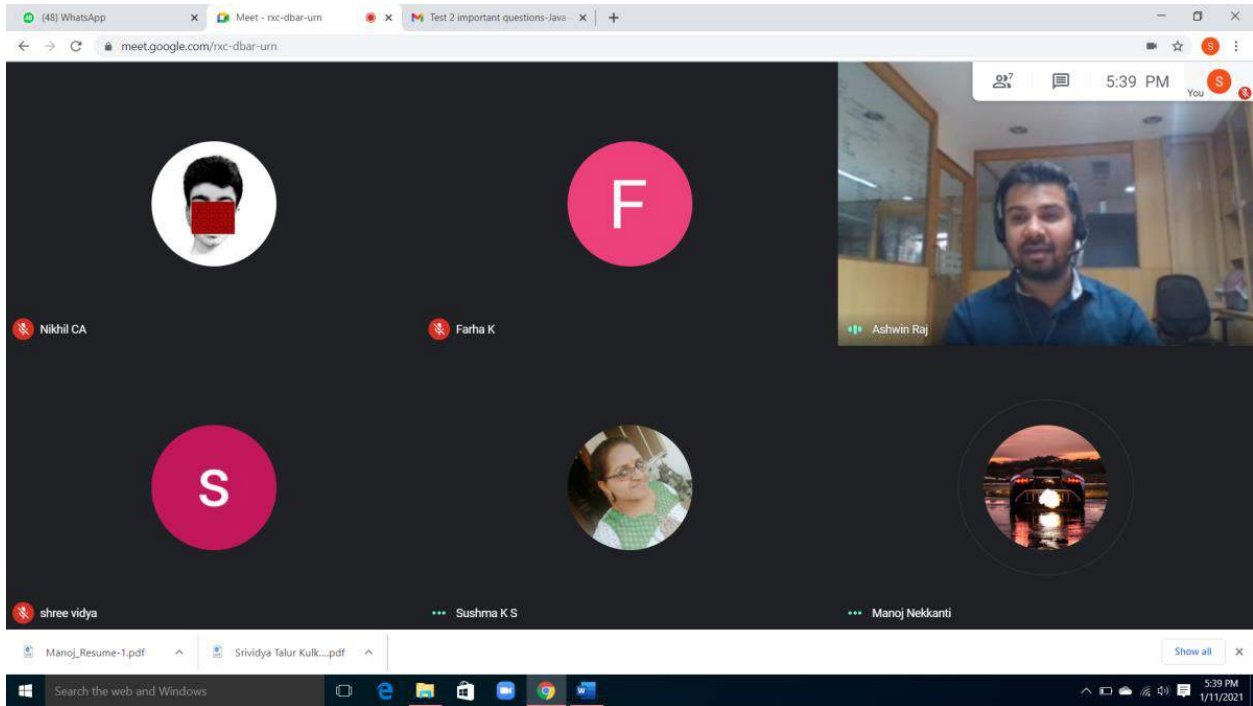


Photo 5 : Group 5 interview

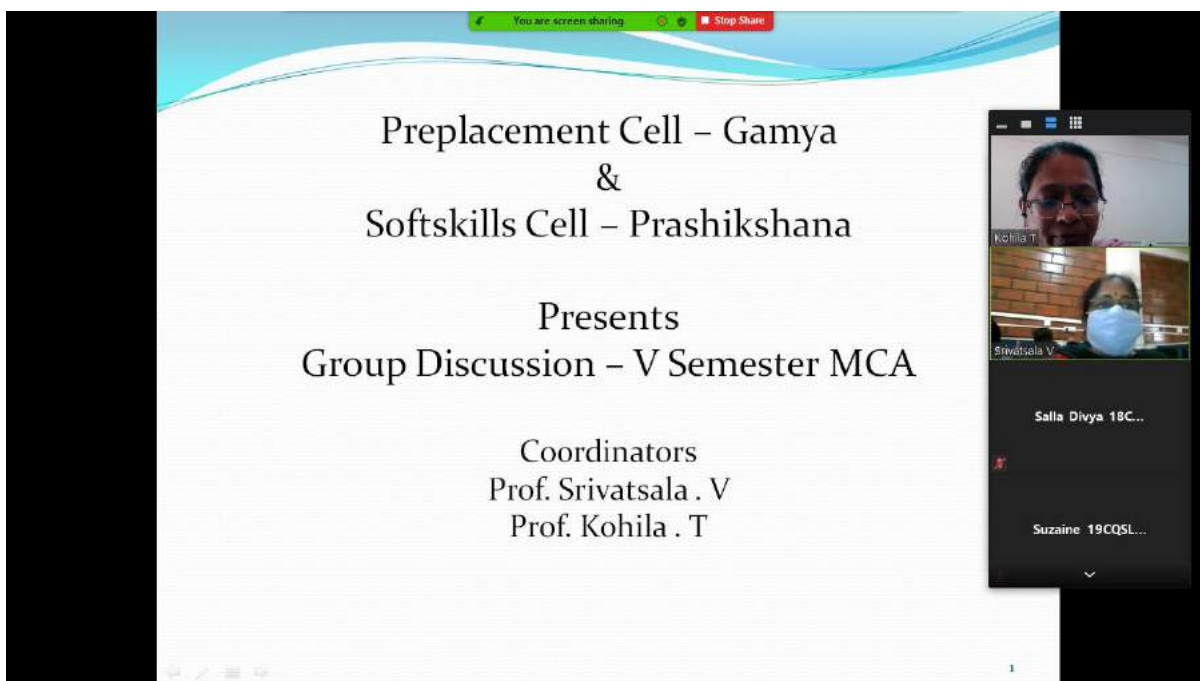



Photo 1 : Prof Kohila starting the session for Group Discussion .

## Do's


1. Be a good listener

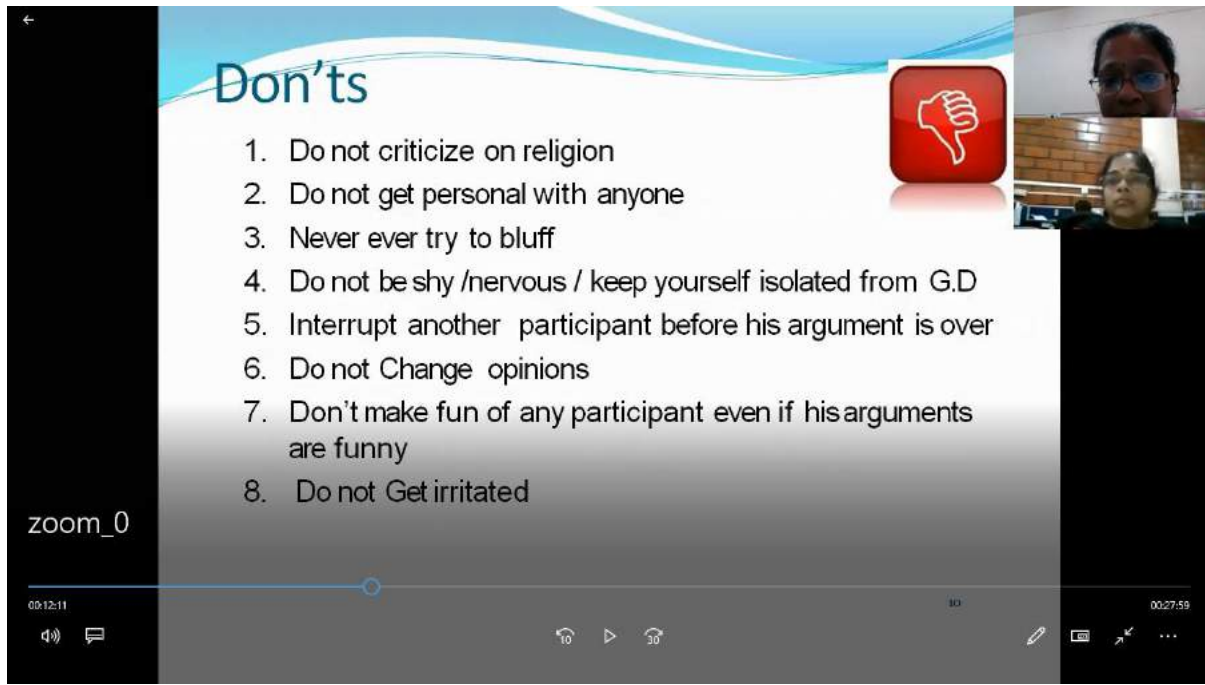


Photo 4 : Don't's of the Group Discussion

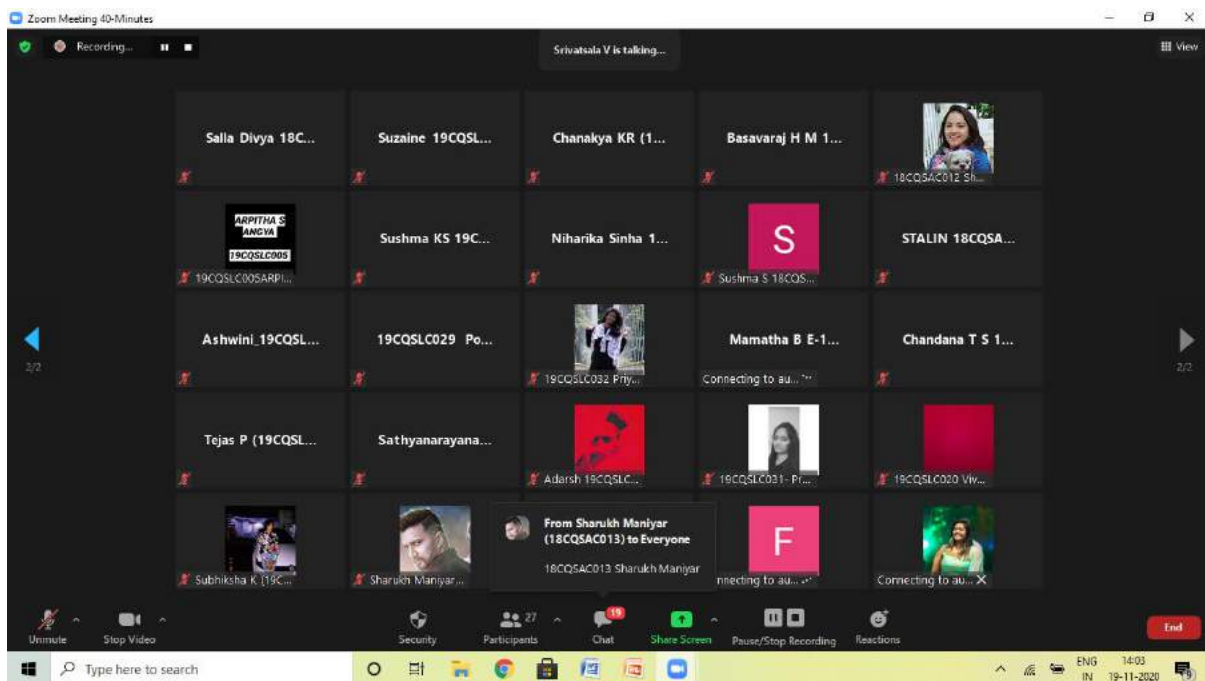


Photo 5: Gallery view of the participants

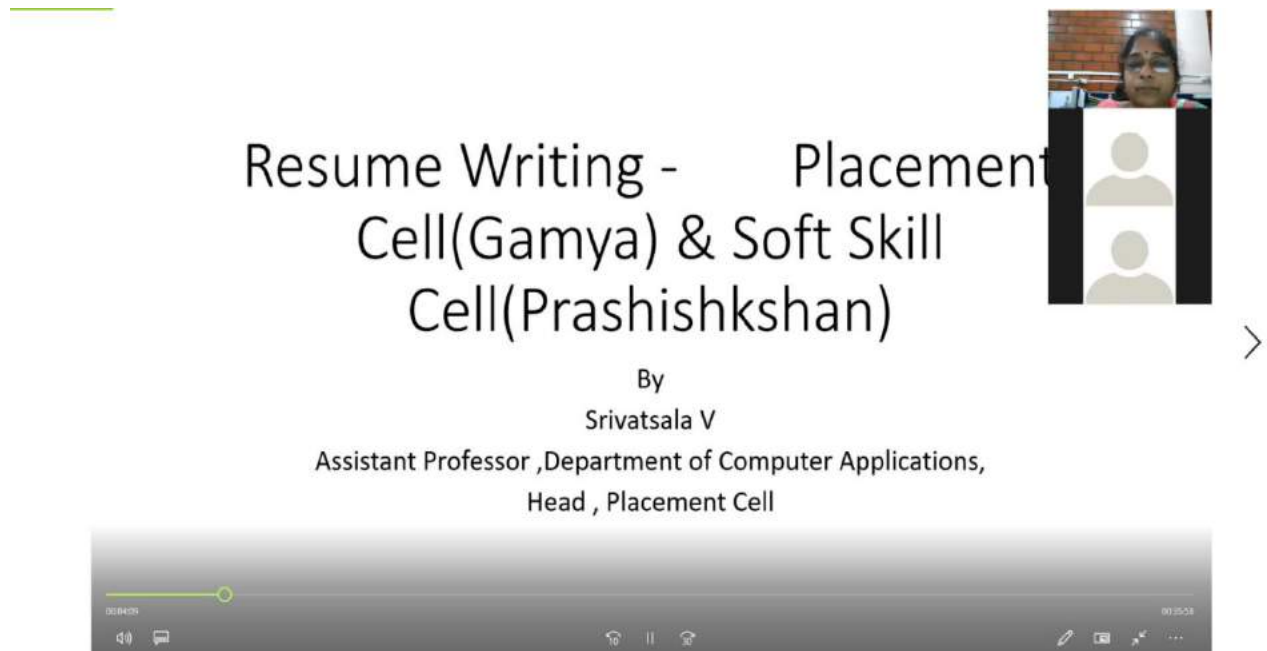



Photo 1 : ResumeWriting session from Placement Cell .



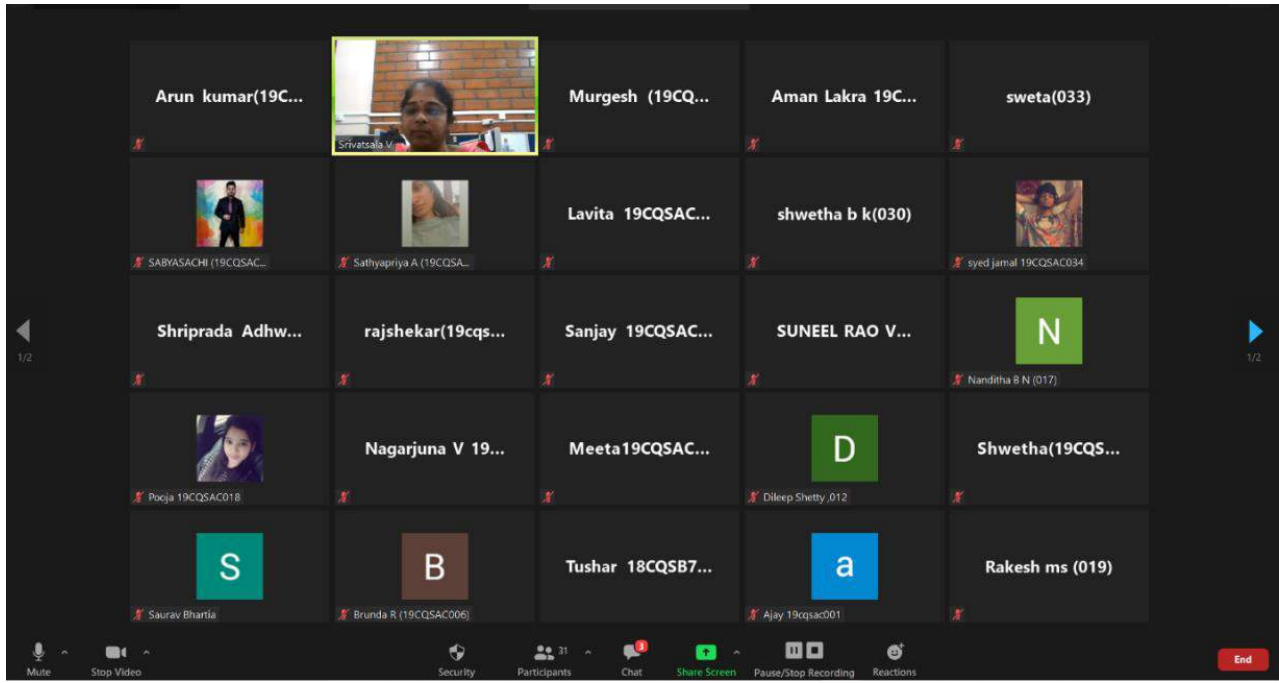


Photo 5 : Participants gallery view

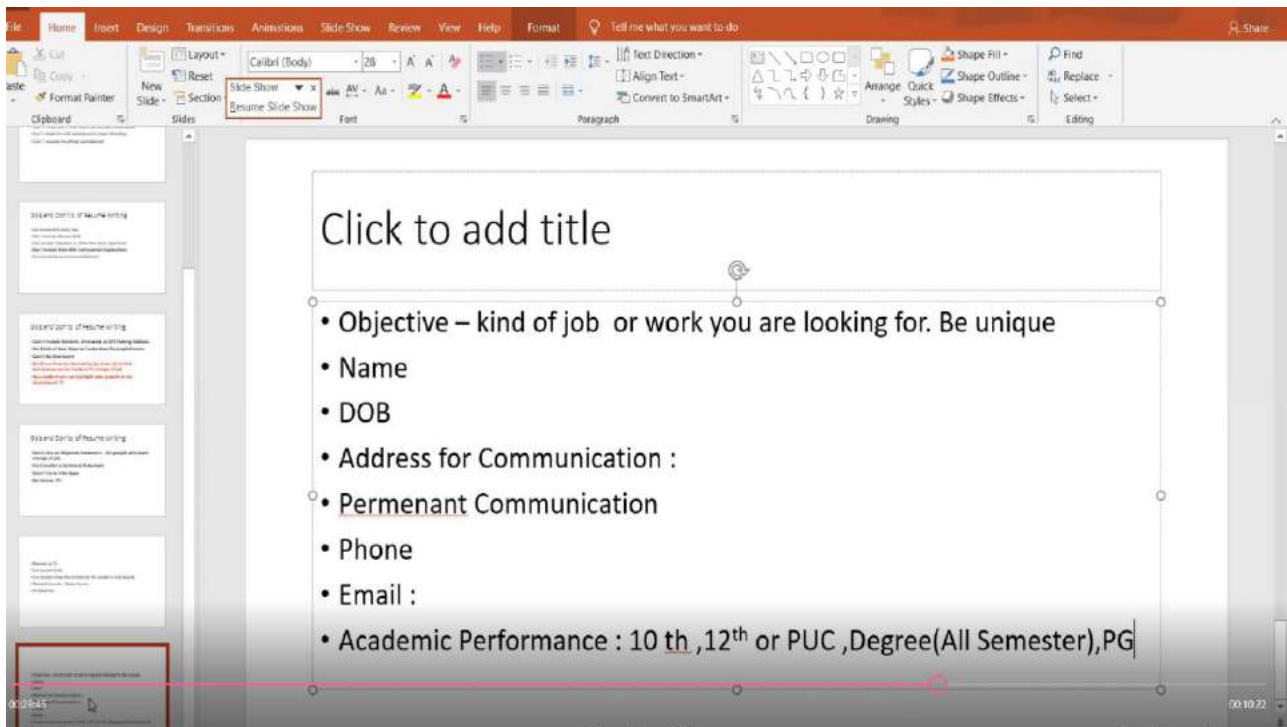


Photo 6: Sample Resume Preparation
