Resource person spoke about how the European Countries and the East India Company capitalized on the caste system in India to their advantage and spoke about the drain theory. Madam elaborated on women's education and their rights. She highlighted their struggle for voting rights in countries such as the USA, despite it being the 1st country to have a written constitution. Also spoke about Dr B R Ambedkar, his knowledge, his research and the books he has authored.</p> <p>Madam suggested students to read the Indian Constitution, biographies and autobiographies of eminent personalities, freedom fighters, India's freedom struggle movement, the Hindu Code Bill to enrich their knowledge. During the Q&A session, she answered the questions regarding the need and the true objective of reservations in the context of equity and how unfortunately, it has become a part of political tactics.</p>
