Annual Report on Entrepreneurship Cell (From July-Aug. 2021 to July-Aug. 2022)

Entrepreneurship cell in DSCASC aims to promote the spirit of entrepreneurship among students to start their own enterprise. The cell provides a platform for students to develop ideas to become a business talent. The idea is to foster and facilitate innovation and entrepreneurship among the students through mentoring, trainings and workshops and help an innovator of today to become an entrepreneur of tomorrow. In this regard it has close relationship with various agencies and organized various activities in the recent past.

MBA, M.Com ,B.Com & BBA departments organized various activities. A brief of these

activities is as follows-

1.On 24th of January 2022 which happens to be the National Girl Child Day Department of BBA/B.Com under the Women Dignity Cell (SHAKTHI) and Entrepreneurship Cell (UDYAMITA) organized webinar title 'Revisiting the Girl effect: Policy and Agency Level Interventions for Women Empowerment". Dr. Roopa Patvardhan Assistant Professor in Department of Economics at Christ (deemed to be university) was the resource person, the speaker spoke on the importance of National Girl Child Day which is celebrated in India every year on January 24th.
