Report on ICRACMT-2022

Day1 (15.12.2022)

The first day of the conference began with Dr. Sumeru Aluru, MBA Department, introducing the theme. This was followed by the IQAC Coordinator, Conference Convener, Prof. Gurunath delivered Welcome Speech, who welcomed everyone to the conference, including Dr. Kosga Yagappa Raj of Putra International College in Malaysia, Ms. Natasha Sagar, Joint Secretary, DSI, Principal, Director MBA, HOD's, Faculty, and conference participants, all academic partner including Primax foundation.

At the inaugural address, Principal Dr. Nagaraj Shenoy gave a brief summary of the most recent developments in IT, business, and management and acknowledged the contributions of each field. He stressed on the interactions between business and technology and emphasized on collaborative efforts to faster growths.

Later, Joint Secretary of DSI Ms. Natasha Sagar emphasized three topics on current technological trends in her presidential address. She began by discussing the effects of AI and ML, how mobile commerce empowered rural India, and how digitization in the context of management accelerated the rate of adoption in the majority of businesses.

Marketing is Dr. Kosga Yagappa Raj's area of expertise. In his keynote address, titled "From Offline Marketing to Online Marketing", he asserted that we may draw on our prior experiences to meet our goals for the future in business, management, and IT. Due to advancements in technology, we transitioned from face-to-face instruction to online instruction. Online instruction was not permitted in the past, but the UGC now approves of it. He explained that whereas people had previously been experts in one field but not in another, because to advancements, anyone could now become both not only "jack of all but master of All".

Dr. Salini Suresh, conference Convener & Head of Research and IPR Cell gave the Vote of Thanks.

In the Second session, Commerce and Management Track1, Dr. Jyotirmayee Reddy, Associate

professor Faculty of management studies, Marwadi University, served as the session chair along

with Dr. Sumeru Aluru being co-chair gave presenters the opportunity to showcase their work

online. 16 research themes were covered by the presenters in this session.

The post lunch session was anchored by Prof. Srivatsala, from Computer Applications and the

technical talk regarding "Approach for Spam mail detection using Machine learning" was held at

2:00 pm by Dr. Debabrata Samanta, an assistant professor at Kosovo's Rochester Institute of

Technology in Europe.

From 2:30 till 4 pm, the computer science track's paper presentations took place. There were a

total of 13 papers presented during the session. Dr. Piyush Kumar Pareek of Nitte Meenakshi

College presided over this meeting's session, with Prof. Srivatsala serving as the co-chair.

By the close of the day, there were two tracks for commerce and management, with break-out

sessions on one track from 2:30 to 4 pm and on the other from 4 pm to 5 pm. During this period,

about 23 papers were presented, with Dr. Savita Trivedi and Dr. Suplab Podder, Head, BBA dept.

serving as the session's chairs, respectively. with Dr. Subbulakshmi, BBA and B.Com Department

and Dr. Deepika Sharma BBAB.Com department serving as Cochairs.

Day2 (16.12.2022)

10:00 Am

Session: Keynote

Dr Anubha Jain, Head (CS), IIS (Deemed to be University), Jaipur delivered the keynote address.

She spoke on the topic "Go Green with the Blue: The mantra for the sustainable world". She spoke

about the SMAC (social, mobile, analytics and cloud) concept and opined that the convergence of

these four technologies is currently driving the business innovation. Considering the drastic rise in

data centers and carbon footprint, she also spoke about the need for energy forecasts and green environments.

Session 11:00: Track - Computer Science

Dr. Suma V, vice principal and head of the computer science and design department of Dayananda Sagar College of Engineering, served as the session's chair, and Prof. Srivatsala served as cochair. During the session, 12 presenters gave presentations of their research.

Session 1:30-2Pm -- Technical Talk

Mr.Amit Choudary, Associate Director, KPMG Global services, India, delivered a technical talk on "Smarter and Scalable AI". He thrusted upon changing dynamics of business while emphasizing on the need for technological breakthroughs. Mr.Choudary also talked about cloud computing and artificial intelligence radically changing the way business and is conducted.

Session: Presentation – Commerce and Management 2-4Pm

Dr. MARY METILDA.J, Associate professor at Christ University in Bangalore, and Dr. Subbulakshmi, served as cochairs for the session. Participants in this session delivered 16 papers in total.
