**CELL ANNUAL REPORT 2022-2023**

One of the important committees set up to promote a healthy and sound learning environment while achieving educational goals and objectives is the anti-ragging committee. The anti-ragging committee posted information on the notice board and on the college website. During the inaugural session Principal of the college oriented the Fresher's batch regarding the anti-ragging measures initiated by the college and explained about the zero-tolerance policy of the institution.

The anti-ragging circular's provision was thoroughly explained, and it highlighted the punishment intended for the offense. The anti-ragging cell helps staff members to guide the newly admitted students to their appropriate classes during the induction program. Every academic year, a committee to combat ragging is formed, and the cautionary boards are installed at key locations around campus.


To establish a campus free of ragging, the anti-ragging cell, PRABALA, organizes awareness campaigns, quizzes, street plays, skits, and other events. To ensure the students' safety, the anti-ragging squad patrols sensitive areas such as parking lots, canteens, food courts, hostel grounds, etc. As a result, the committee does not receive a single ragging-related complaint. However, ragging awareness campaigns are a common occurrence on campuses.

At the time of admission, all students were required to sign anti-ragging undertakings in accordance with government directives. The document's submission validates the students' commitment to abiding by the government's anti-ragging program. For the convenience of the students, UGC Guidelines and a sample anti-ragging undertaking form were made available on the college website. Numerous initiatives have been made to raise student awareness of anti-ragging campaigns.

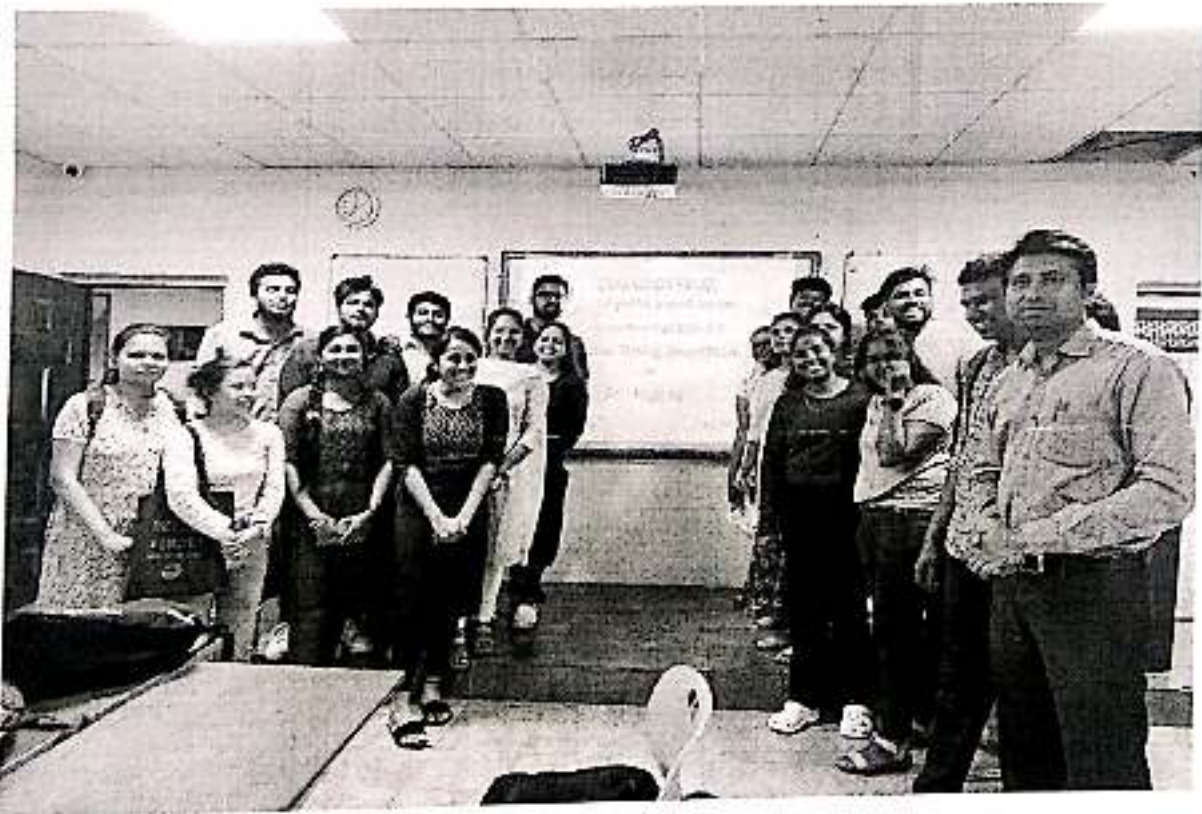

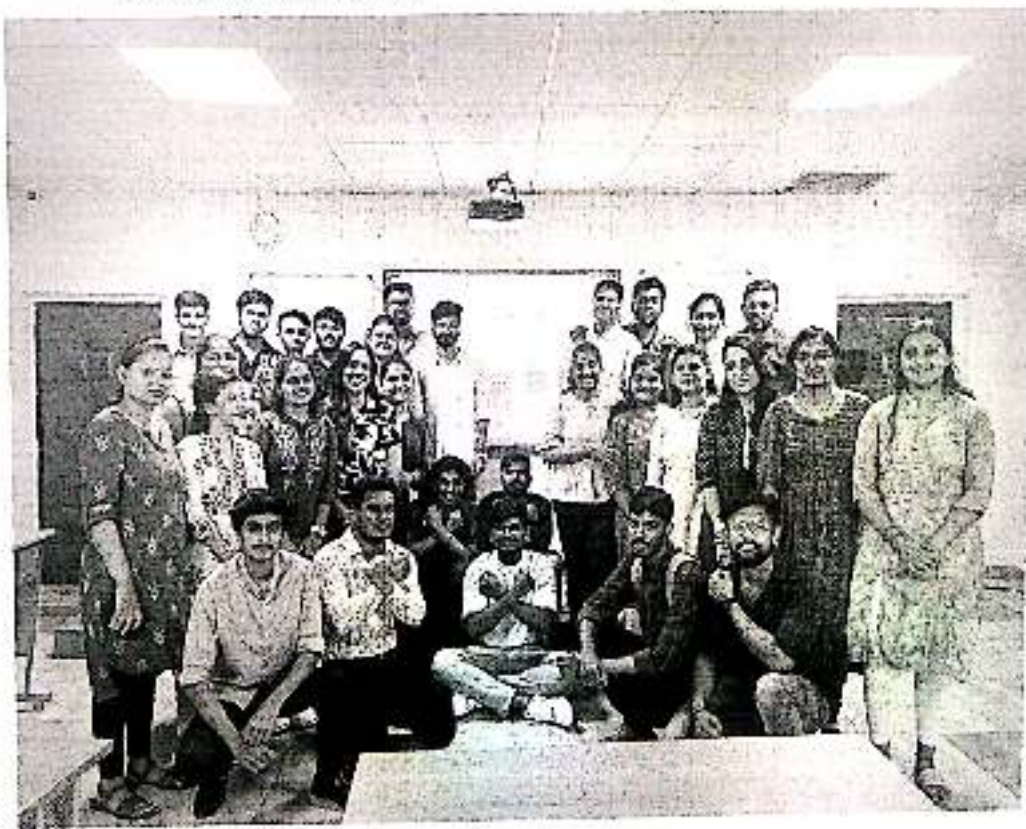

**Zero Tolerance towards Ragging: Creating Safe Educational Spaces**



- Acts or actions which can be interpreted as physical assault
- Hazing or dangerous initiations
- Threat or act towards assault of any kind be it mental or physical
- Threats or actions to harm others and self or endanger the safety of others
- Behaviours or actions interpreted as potential for violence and/or acts of aggression
- Threats to destroy or the actual destruction of property
- Possession of a firearm, knife or any dangerous weapon, drugs and/or alcohol/ tobacco or any substance of intoxication (to include being under the influence of prohibited drugs or alcohol)
- Violation of college safety rules.




