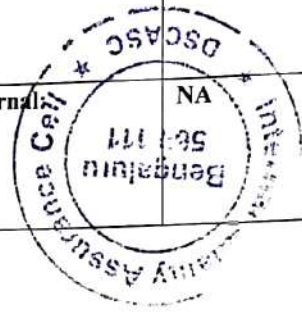

Summary of the Event (Around 100 words)	<p>The HR Club YUKTHI – Think, Lead, Transform, in association with the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), organized The Unblowable House Challenge on 24 June 2026 for the II Semester 'A' Section MBA students. Inspired by the timeless story of The Three Little Pigs, the activity aimed to provide an experiential understanding of key Human Capital Management concepts such as strategic planning, teamwork, resource optimization, resilience, adaptability, and effective decision-making. Students were divided into teams and challenged to design and construct a freestanding paper house using a limited set of materials within a duration of 45 minutes. The completed houses were then tested using a table fan to simulate external organizational pressures and uncertainties, with the objective of building a structure capable of withstanding the force. Following the challenge, an interactive discussion enabled participants to reflect on their planning process, role allocation, collaboration, and problem-solving approaches. The activity effectively drew parallels between constructing a resilient house and developing a strong organizational workforce through sound HR practices. By integrating creativity with practical learning, the event enhanced students' critical thinking, leadership, communication, coordination, and team-building skills while reinforcing the significance of building strong foundations to achieve long-term organizational success in a dynamic business environment.</p>

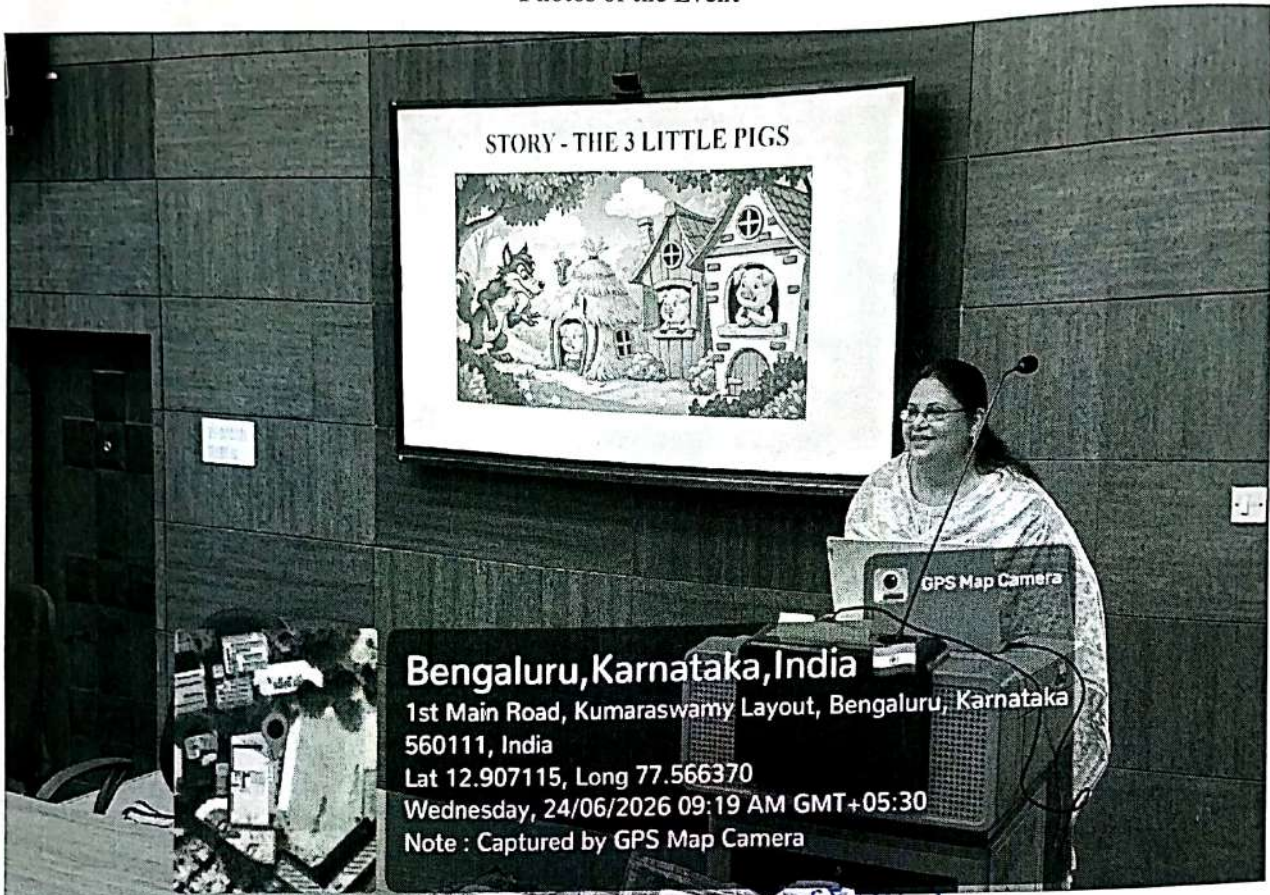

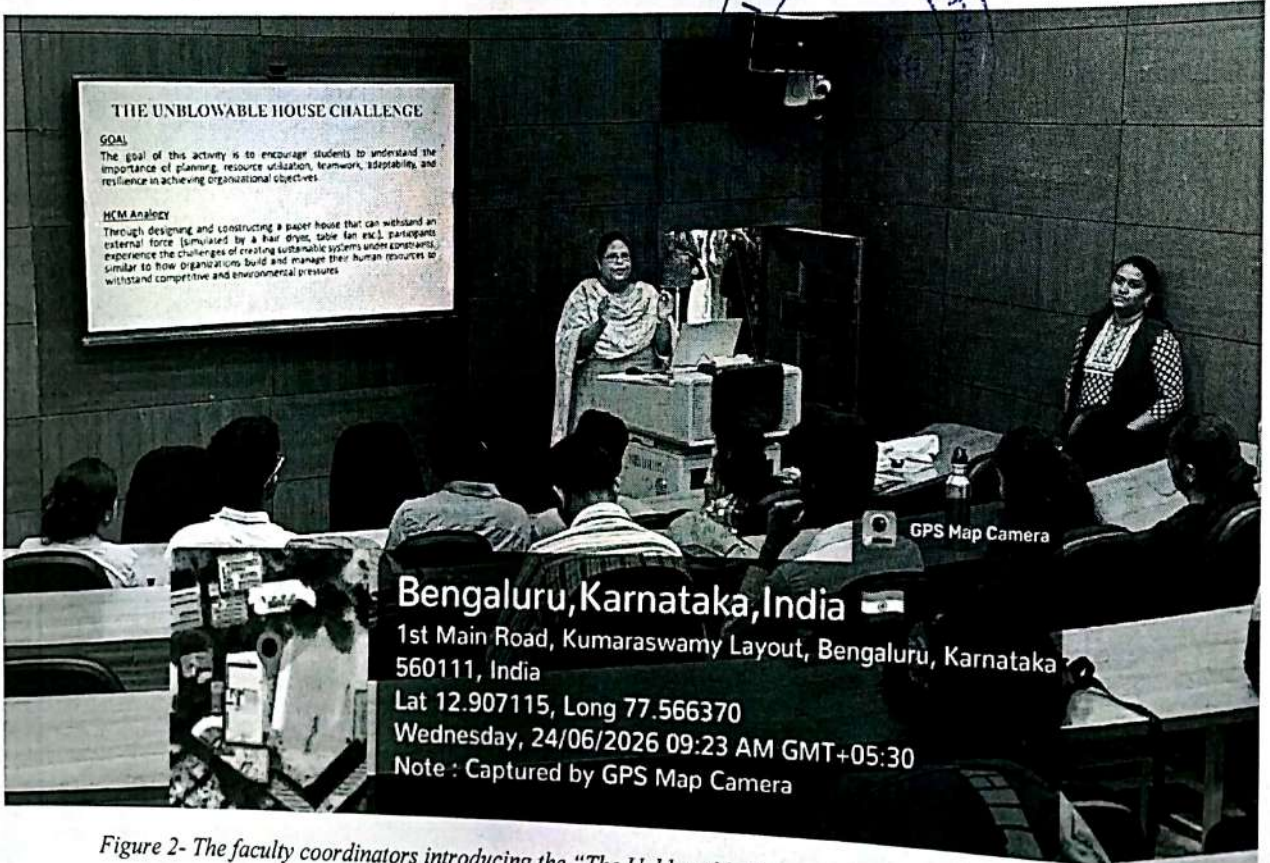

GOAL
The goal of this activity is to encourage students to understand the importance of planning, resource utilization, teamwork, adaptability, and resilience in achieving organizational objectives.
HCM Analysis

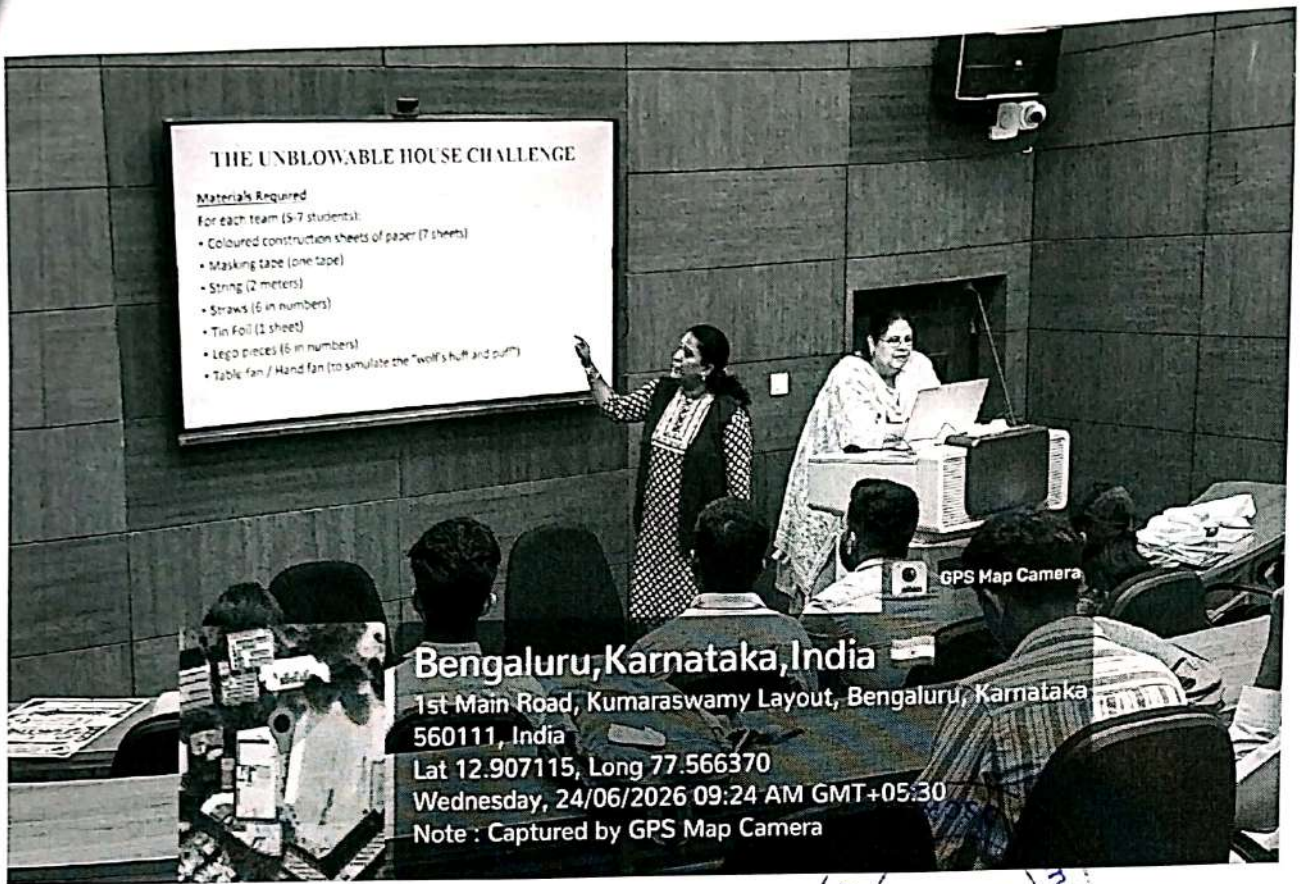


Figure 3 – Dr. Nayana introducing the materials required for the workshop

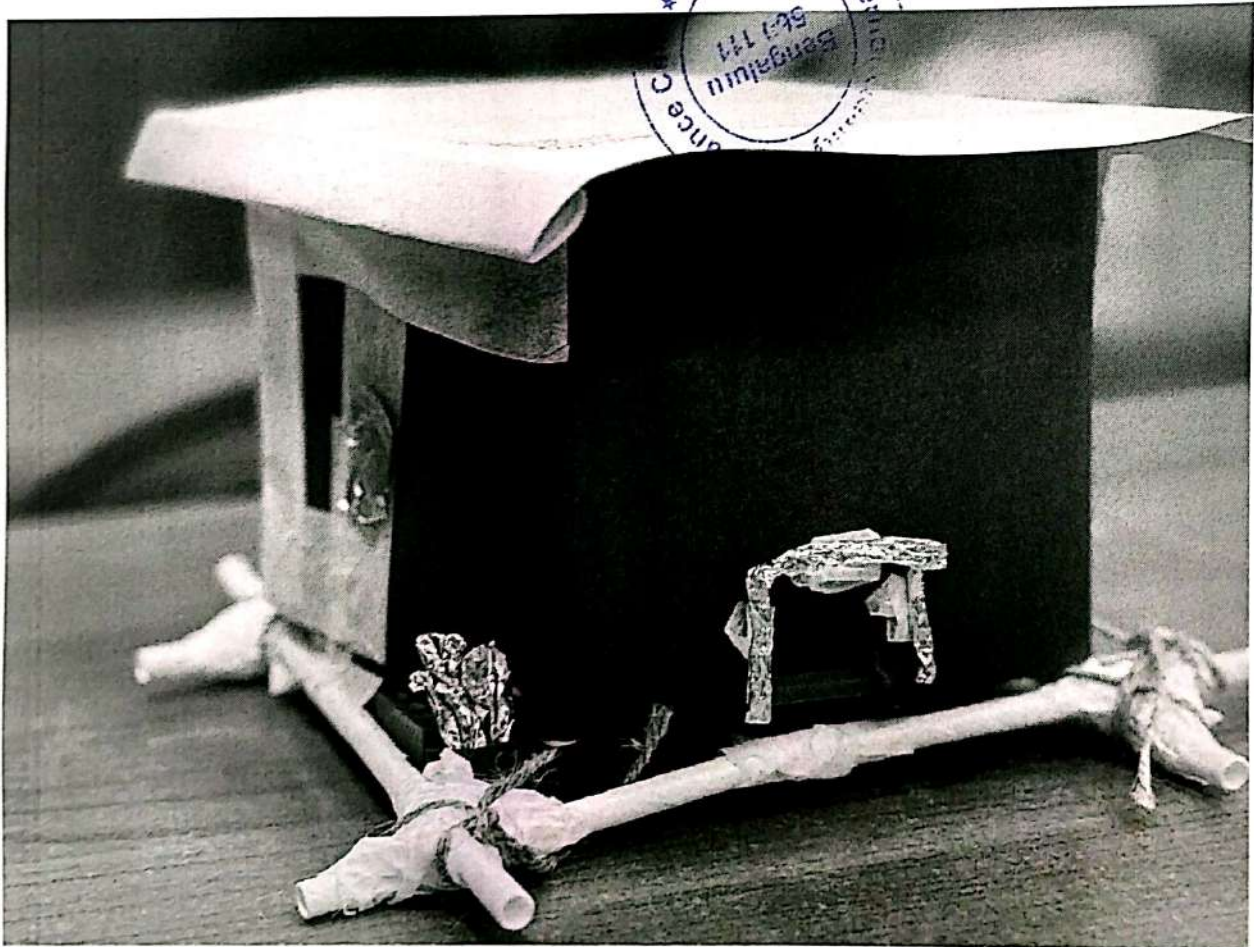


Figure 8 – A sample house designed by the student

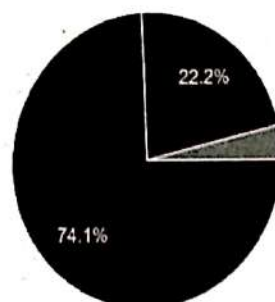

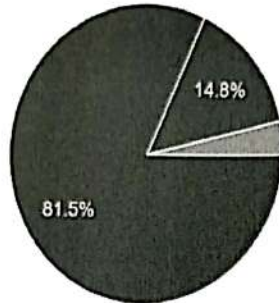
